Mis hermanos y hermanas,

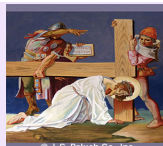

Llamados a ser Vecinos de Todos - El Enfoque Cuaresmal Parroquial

Querida Familia de San Patricio,

Los Oblatos Asociados en la parroquia, junto con el Padre Tom, piden que hasta ahora estén teniendo un buen reto Cuaresmal! Además queremos agradecer a todos los que han participado hasta ahora en nuestro esfuerzo parroquial para crecer como Buenos Samaritanos a través de las biblias y libros espirituales que nos trajeron la semana pasada y hoy. El Padre Paul los estará distribuyendo a nuestros vecinos en la prision.

Para continuar con el reto del Papa Francisco nos da en Fratelli tutti, para ponernos serios sobre vivir como Buenos Vecinos, queremos invitarlos en esta semana y la próxima a reflexionar sobre una pequeña cita del Papa Francisco que se encuentra en el capítulo 2 de esta carta. Puede encontrar la cita en su banca. El papa nos reta a seguir despertando a cuan indiferentes nos hemos convertido especialmente porque estamos ocupados y seguido juzgamos a otros como si no fueran dignos de nuestra ayuda. El escribe:

“Todos temenos maneras de no ver.... de resistirnos a las demandas...o filtrar los llamados que interrumpen nuestro camino o nuestras propias preocupaciones (§63 ff; 70;73;74). Nuestras sociedades tienen buena práctica en darnos razones para no ver al lastimado en el camino...o convertir su vulnerabilidad en su fracas moral, de hecho, haciendo ver nuestro paso cercas como una clase de virtud. Los lastimados pueden ser tratados con sospecha, quizás sean ellos quienes nos estan tendiendo una trampa o, ¿porqué pagamos impuestos?¿Que no es responsabilidad del Estado o de alguien más encargarse de esto? (§75) Hay un sin fin de formas en que podemos justificar nuestro pasar por el otro lado.... (§57;) Nos hemos acostumbrado a mirar hacia el otro lado, pasar, ignorando la situacion hasta que nos afecta directamente.” (§64)

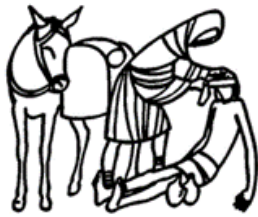
La mayoría de nosotros probablemente hemos decidido lo que queremos hacer para la Cuaresma. La historia del Buen Samaritano pone en claro: Dios también decide lo que se necesita de nosotros y seguidolo hace poniendo a alguien en nuestra mente, o poniendo en nuestro camino diario a alguien quien necesita el amor y cuidado de Dios.

Esta semana le invitamos a tomar la tarjeta de reflexión que se encuentra en su banca y llevarsela a casa. Manténgala donde la pueda ver: en su refrigerados, en el espejo del baño, en el tablero de su carro, en su libro de oraciones diarias o tome una foto y póngala como imagen en la pantalla de su teléfono por las siguientes dos semanas. Es un recordatorio para mantener sus ojos abiertos hacia donde Dios le está llamando, en cualquier día, a ser un Buen Vecino, Buen Samaritano en este mundo a quien Dios ama.

Entonces, en las dos semanas que siguen le invitamos a escribir, anonimamente, en la parte de atrás de estas tarjetas, una palabra o dos que identifiquen cómo fue usted llamado y como respondió a ser un Buen Vecino la semana anterior. Pueden dejar las tarjetas en una canasta que se encontrará cercas de la mesa del ofertorio cuando entra a la Iglesia. Las tarjetas serán llevadas junto con su ofrenda financiera como otra forma de ofrenda que desea darle a Dios como respuesta al llamado a cuidar de los olvidados, ignorados, juzgados o de quienes simplemente pasamos por un lado.

Las tarjetas serán quemadas en nuestra última venta de Pescado Frito como símbolo de nuestros esfuerzos por ser parte del amor de Cristo que dá luz a la obscuridad del mundo. *Called to Be Neighbors to All -
Our Parish Lenten Focus*

Dear St. Patrick's Family,

The Oblate Associates in the parish, along with Fr. Tom, pray you are having a good and challenging Lent so far! We also want to thank all who have participated so far in our parish effort to grow as Good Samaritans through the bibles and spiritual readings you brought last week and today. Fr. Paul will be distributing these to our neighbors in prison.

To continue the challenge Pope Francis gives us in *Fratelli tutti*, to get serious about living as Good Neighbors, we want to invite you this week and next to reflect on a short quote from Pope Francis found in chapter 2 of his letter. The quote can be found on the index cards in your pew. The pope challenges us to keep waking up to how indifferent we've all become especially because we are busy and we often judge others as not really worthy of our help. He writes:

“We all have ways of not seeing.... of resisting demands...or filtering out the cries that disturb or disrupt our journey or our own concerns (§63 ff; 70;73;74). Our societies are well practiced at giving us reasons for not seeing the wounded on the road...or converting their vulnerability into their moral failure, actually making our passing by a sort of virtue. The wounded can be treated with suspicion, perhaps it is they who are setting a trap for us or why do we pay taxes? Isn't it the responsibility of the State or someone else to deal with this? (§75) There is no end to the way we can justify our passing by on the other side.... (§57;) We have become accustomed to looking the other way, passing by, ignoring situations until they affect us directly.” (§64)

The majority of us have probably decided what we want to do for Lent. The Good Samaritan story makes clear: God also decides what is needed from us and often does this by bringing someone to mind, or putting someone along our daily path, who needs God's love and care.

This week we invite you to take the reflection card in your pew home with you. Keep it where you can see it: on your refrigerator, bathroom mirror, dashboard, daily prayer book or, take a picture and make it your phone's screen cover for the next two weeks. It is a reminder to keep your eyes open to where or how God is calling you, on any given day, to be a Good Neighbor, Good Samaritan in this world God so loves.

Then, in the two weeks that will follow we invite you to write, anonymously, on the back of these cards, a word or two that identifies how you were called and responded to be a Good Neighbor in the past week. You can drop the cards in a basket which will be near the offertory table when you enter the Church. The cards will be brought up with your financial offering as another type of offering you want to give God in answer to the call to care for those forgotten, ignored, judged or simply passed by.

The cards will be burned at our last Friday Fish Fry as a symbol of our efforts to be part of Christ's love that gives light to the darkness of the world.
