

SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Parents must be registered and active parishioners of St. Michael's (regularly attending mass, using envelopes, and involved in ministries), for at least 3 months. Before scheduling a baptism, you must attend a baptism class at St. Michael's. (Next class is August 10 at 10am in Room 103.) Only one parent must attend so that the other can take care of the child(ren) at home. Godparents must also be active, practicing Catholics. Baptisms are normally the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month at 11:30 am in the church. Please call the parish office to register for a baptism.

Immaculée Ilibagiza was born and raised in a small village in Rwanda, Africa. In April of 1994, the Hutu president of Rwanda was assassinated and the massacre of the Tutsi tribe members began. Men, women, and children were slaughtered. Immaculée and seven other women hid in a pastor's hidden 3×4 ft bathroom. She remained there for 91 days and prayed the rosary, turning her life towards God and away from hate.

Hear her story on Wednesday, September 4th in the church. Mass will be at 6:30pm followed by Immaculée's talk at 7pm.
