Cada 14 de septiembre se celebra la fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz, día en que recordamos y honramos la cruz en la que murió nuestro Señor Jesucristo. La contemplación de aquel madero, en el que nuestro Salvador vertió su preciosísima sangre, es puerta abierta al misterio del amor divino, derramado sin medida sobre el género humano.
