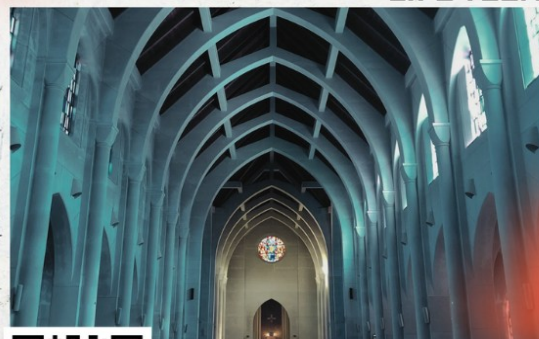

DOMINGO XXVIII DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO ¿Y LOS OTROS NUEVE, DONDE ESTÁN?



El Evangelio de este domingo (cf. Lc 17,11-19) nos invita a reconocer con admiración y gratitud los dones de Dios. En el camino que lo lleva a la muerte y a la resurrección, Jesús encuentra a diez leprosos que salen a su encuentro, se paran a lo lejos y expresan a gritos su desgracia ante aquel hombre, en el que su fe ha intuido un posible salvador: Jesús, maestro, ten compasión de nosotros. Están enfermos y buscan a alguien que los cure. Jesús les responde y les indica que vayan a presentarse a los sacerdotes que, según la Ley, tenían la misión de constatar una eventual

curación. De este modo, no se limita a hacer una promesa, sino que pone a prueba su fe. De hecho, en ese momento ninguno de los diez ha sido curado todavía. Recobran la salud mientras van de camino, después de haber obedecido a la palabra de Jesús. Entonces, llenos de alegría, se presentan a los sacerdotes, y luego cada uno se irá por su propio camino, olvidándose del Donador, es decir del Padre, que los ha curado a través de Jesús, su Hijo hecho hombre.

Sólo uno es la excepción: un samaritano, un extranjero que vive en las fronteras del pueblo elegido, casi un pagano. Este hombre no se conforma con haber obtenido la salud a través de propia fe, sino que hace que su curación sea plena, regresando para manifestar su gratitud por el don recibido, reconociendo que Jesús es el verdadero Sacerdote que, después de haberlo levantado y salvado, puede ponerlo en camino y recibirlo entre sus discípulos. Nos podemos preguntar: ¿Somos capaces de saber decir gracias? ¿Cuántas veces nos decimos gracias en familia, en la comunidad, en la Iglesia? ¿Cuántas veces damos gracias a quien nos ayuda, a quien está cerca de nosotros, a quien nos acompaña en la vida? Con frecuencia damos todo por descontado. Y lo mismo hacemos también con Dios. Es fácil ir al Señor para pedirle algo, pero regresar a darle las gracias... Por eso Jesús remarca con fuerza la negligencia de los nueve leprosos desagradecidos: ¿No han quedado limpios los diez? Los otros nueve, ¿dónde están? ¿No ha vuelto más que este extranjero para dar gloria a Dios? Para saber agradecer se necesita también la humildad.

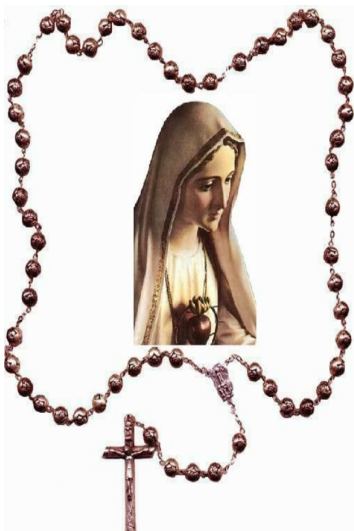
