

BUILDING FOR OUR CHILDREN AND OUR CONGREGATION

What does the expansion of the Education Building include?

The Education Building Project will begin May 28, 2019. Over the summer months, and prior to the actual building expansion, the Education Building will undergo a remodeling phase which will include: updating the 4 adult bathrooms, replacing the flooring and carpeting, updating the HVAC system, redoing the lighting and ceiling tiles, replacing the windows in rooms 109 and 127, adding new entry doors, and painting the building. Once these changes are made, the front of the building will be walled off, and construction will begin on the additional 4 classrooms, 2 offices, the covered walkway, and then the bell tower.



An overnight warming station (OWS) is short-term emergency housing that opens when temperatures or a combination of precipitation, wind and temperature become dangerously inclement. The paramount



purpose is the prevention of death and injury from exposure to the elements. In recent years, the Salvation Army-Plano has served as an OWS site.

The Collin County Homeless Coalition - Interfaith group is now looking for volunteers for the OWS for this upcoming winter.
