

St. Jude is expanding its columbarium for parish members and their families, with plans to break ground in late spring of 2022. The same design team that worked on the church's

bell tower has been selected to reimagine the columbarium's resting space. New features include a central garden with a statue of the Good Shepherd as a focal point, and surrounding accent landscaping. The updated columbarium will include 300 new niches accessible from four entry points, including the St. Jude Chapel.


