

#### Peace and blessings!

This week's daily Masses will be offered in the Padre Pio Chapel while some repairs are taking place in the church. As you come out of the church, turn to your right and the Center will be on your left, 619 Jefferson St. Mass times will be the same.

The Feast of All Saints, November 1st, is not a Holy Day of obligation because it falls on a Saturday this year. Mass will be at 9:00am as it is every Saturday.

Next weekend we will have our Ministry Fair, an opportunity to see the various groups that are part of St. Ann Parish and get involved. Weather permitting, it will be held outside in front of the office and Saint Ann statue.

This is the first of two parables that Jesus tells in Luke 18 about prayer. (The second will be read at Mass next Sunday.) This first parable is a lesson in persistence in prayer. The lesson is about the persistence of the one who prays. God wants us to be like the persistent widow, staying in relationship with God, confident that God hears and answers prayers. We must understand Jesus to be saying that if even an unjust judge responds to the persistence of the widow, how much more so will God listen to our prayers.



#### Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available in Church each Saturday from 4:00pm-4:45pm or call the Parish Office to make appointment.

#### Sacrament of Baptism

Upon the birth of your child, parents please contact the Parish Office for orientation and to register for the required Parents and Godparents' Baptismal Preparation Session. The sessions are currently available online. Baptisms are celebrated the first and third Sundays of the month following the 12:00pm Mass, at 1:00pm.

#### Sacrament of Marriage

Couples are to be registered, active members of the parish and are asked to begin preparation at least one year

prior to the planned wedding date. It is advisable for couples to contact the Parish Office before other arrangements are made for the Wedding Day.

### Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick/Visitation of the Sick

The Anointing of the Sick is available to seriously ill members of our Parish either at home or in the hospital. For legal reasons, many hospitals no longer inform parishes when a hospitalized parishioner would like a parish visit. Please call the Parish Office to make arrangements.
