

Edward Has a Home for the Holidays

Edward's story begins in Hoboken, where he was born into a family deeply woven into the city's history. His grandfather owned a popular business downtown and relatives were always close by.

After a lifetime of working hard, raising children, running an air-conditioning business, and living independently, everything shifted when disability struck in his early 60s. By his 70s, a sudden loss of income led to an eviction he never saw coming. With nowhere left to turn, Edward found himself discouraged, depressed, and completely on his own.

He knew about The Hoboken Shelter from his ties to the City, and a year ago, he came through our doors seeking warmth, safety, and stability. This month, just in time for the holidays, Edward is moving into his own home right where he was born in Hoboken.

The FOURTH WEEK of ADVENT

In this Fourth Week of Advent, our final days of preparation before Christmas, we ask Christ to forgive us for our sins and through His grace, to create us anew when He comes. This week is also a time to recollect, to reflect on our Advent journey. If we have let the hustle and bustle of the season get in the way of our spiritual preparations for Christmas, we have one last chance to refocus—and the light of the candles on the Advent wreath can be a symbol of our focus, as well as a symbol of the Light of Christ.



Fourth Week of Advent Prayer

*Bestir, O Lord, Thy might,
we beseech Thee, and come;
and with great power come to our aid,
that, by the help of Thy grace, that which
is hindered by our sins may be hastened
by Thy merciful forgiveness.
Who lives and reigns, with God the Father,
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
God, world without end. Amen*

ADVENT REFLECTION:

Jesus wants to fill everyone with His grace—and He wants to use us to do it. This is especially true during Advent, a season when people can be more open to God and might consider coming to Mass at Christmas. Yet, it's ironic, that at this time of year, we can feel like we're "running on empty" and have little to offer. *Does this describe me?* It describes many of us; don't worry...just ask Jesus to fill you up again the next time you receive Communion.

As we come to the altar to receive the Eucharist, pray:

"Jesus, I believe this is Your Body and Your Blood. Come, Lord, and give me your grace."

Then, after Communion, spend a few moments silently thanking Jesus by praying:

"Thank you Lord for coming to me and uniting Yourself to me. I trust that You are at work now, filling me up. Thank you!"

If we do this each and every time we receive the Holy Eucharist, we cannot help but be filled to overflowing with grace left over to share!

Prayer: "Thank you, Lord, for giving Yourself to me in the Eucharist. Help me share Your grace with people around me."

Mary Grace Bellotti

Maria Grazia (Mary Grace) Bellotti was an Italian-American laywoman known for her deep faith, acts of charity, and intercessory prayers, which many believed led to miraculous healings. Born in Italy and later settling in the United States, she dedicated her life to serving her community and inspiring others through her devotion. Her legacy continues to be honored by those who remember her as a beacon of hope and compassion.

Mary Grace Bellotti passed away on November 10, 1927, in Palisades Park, New Jersey, at the age of 45. She was laid to rest in Calvary Cemetery in Queens, New York. Her life of devotion and service left an indelible mark on her community, and she is remembered as a model of faith, hope, and love. In the years following her death, efforts were made to honor her memory and recognize her contributions. The St. Gerard Maiella Society was formed in her name, and her story continues to inspire those who seek to live lives of faith and compassion.
