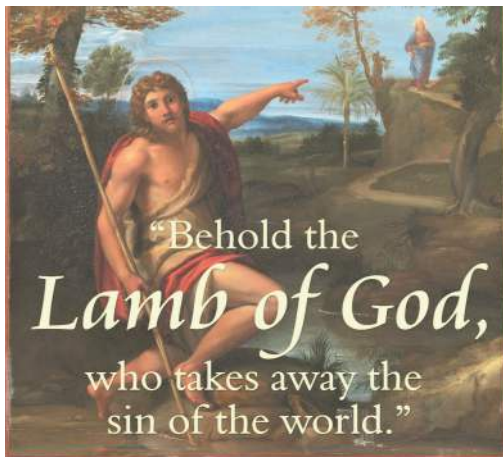

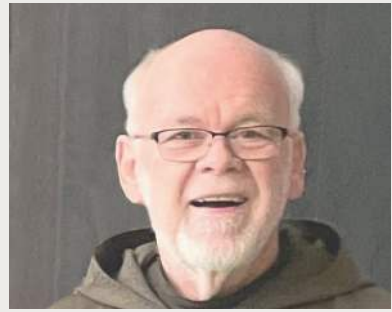

Peace and blessings!

As you will notice in the bulletin, there is a section called "We Are His Witnesses". Each week we will take one of the many questions asked by people in the archdiocese to help give us all some clarity on where this process is going. If you prefer, on the Newark Archdiocese web site there is much more information including suggestions for possible mergers. I just ask that you keep yourself informed so that when decisions are made by the Cardinal, nothing will come as a surprise, but rather you saw it unfolding in the months before. Again, we are called to be his witnesses by the virtue of our Baptism.

While the dates are a bit late, we are still having our WinterChill events. Please look them over and sign up. Some events have limited space. We look forward to seeing as many of you as are able to join us.

This Sunday we break from our reading of Matthew's Gospel (the primary Gospel for our current liturgical cycle, Cycle A) to read from John's Gospel. We heard Matthew's account of Jesus' baptism last Sunday, on the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Today, we hear John the Baptist's testimony about Jesus as found in John's Gospel. John's Gospel differs from the other Gospels because John does not describe Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist. Instead, John the Baptist announces that he knows that Jesus is the Son of God.

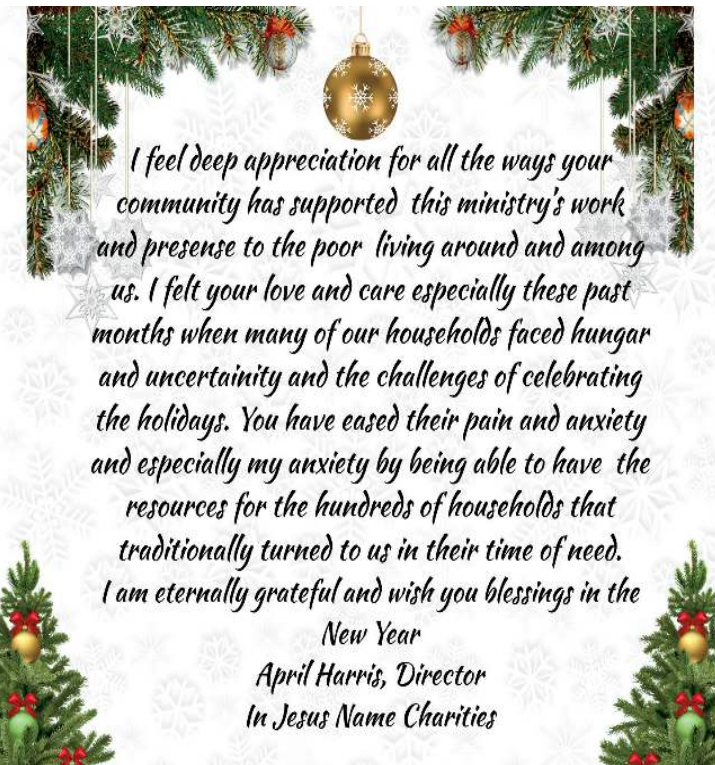

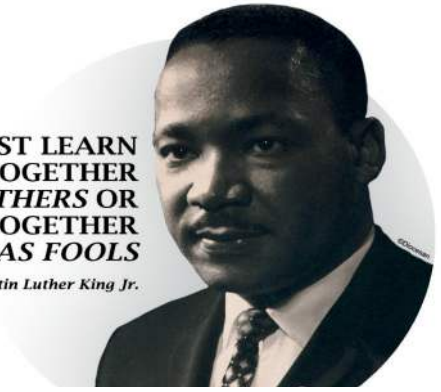

date. It is advisable for couples
to contact the Parish Office
before other arrangements are
made for the Wedding Day.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick/Visitation of the Sick
