

Scripture Reflections

February 1, 2026—4th Sunday in Ordinary Time



"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." MATTHEW 5:3

The phrase "poor in spirit" can be confusing. Think of it in this sense – poor in spirit means depending on God's providence and not depending on our own self-reliance. Being detached from earthly things (power, money, and comfort) and being attached to heavenly things (charity, sacrifice, and mercy). Denying ourselves from satisfying our desires and helping others obtain their basic needs.



Peace and blessings!

God is giving us a time to either enjoy the snow or practice patience. We are looking at patience as a number of things had to be cancelled or delayed. The major issue is with our **Winter Chill**. Please check the website, Facebook or emails for updates. With all this, God is in charge.

Next Saturday, February 7th at 11:00am, we will celebrate a **Healing Mass**. All are invited to attend. If you have any cause for healing - physical, mental or emotional - you will be able to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Coming into church we ask that you sit in every other row. This way the priests will be able to move more easily to go through the church and anoint those who wish. The World Day of Prayer for the Sick is actually on Wednesday, February 11th, the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes.

Lent is just around the corner, Wednesday, February 18th. Be sure to check out the full schedule of Masses/services. While it is NOT a holy day of obligation, it is a great way to begin the season of Lent.

Today's reading is the beginning of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount, which is found in Matthew's Gospel. The form of the Beatitudes found here is not unique to Jesus. Beatitudes are found in the Old Testament, in the psalms, and in wisdom literature, for example. They are a way to teach about who will find favor with God.

available online. Baptisms are
celebrated the first and third
Sundays of the month following
the 12:00pm Mass, at 1:00pm.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples are to be registered,
active members of the parish
and are asked to begin
preparation at least one year

prior to the planned wedding
date. It is advisable for couples
to contact the Parish Office
before other arrangements are
made for the Wedding Day.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick/Visitation of the Sick
