FROM FATHER RICHARD

The Start of Something New

This Sunday, September 15th, is Catechetical Sunday throughout the Diocese of Pittsburgh. At Saint Paul of the Cross Parish, we are launching a new elementary religious education program for Saint Anne and Saint Winifred. The CCD classes are all being held at the Saint Winifred school site on both Sundays and Mondays. The new program combines both classroom instruction and liturgy for our students each week in an attempt to teach our Catholic faith and deepen the worship experience for our parish children. The new program necessitated changes in the Mass schedule at Saint Winifred to coordinate with the time of the CCD classes.

So, as you may already know, Sunday 10am Mass at Saint Winifred has been moved to 11:30am to accommodate the religious education of our students. The Monday morning Mass at 8:45am has been moved to 5:30pm to suit the students attending Monday evening CCD classes. This change hearkens back to the practice of a Monday evening Mass at Saint Winifred for many years.

Other changes in the Sunday Mass schedule at both Saint Anne and Saint Winifred are due to the availability of the priests and planning for the unlikely event of one priest having to celebrate all six Masses at our two churches due to illness or an unforeseen instance. The Saturday vigil Mass at Saint Winifred has been moved to 5:30pm so that the priest could celebrate the 4pm vigil Mass at Saint Anne and drive to Saint Winifred in a reasonable amount of time to do the 5:30pm vigil Mass. The 8:30am Sunday Mass at Saint Anne has been moved back to 8am, with the 10am Mass replacing the former 11am Mass given the new 11:30am Mass at Saint Winifred. Again, if one priest had to celebrate all the Sunday morning Masses at our two churches for some unforeseen reason, he could manage doing the 8am and 10am Masses at Saint Anne and the 11:30am Mass at Saint Winifred.

We ask your indulgence as we implement these changes in the Mass schedule at Saint Paul of the Cross Parish in an attempt to maintain both communities and strengthen the catechetical and liturgical formation of our young people in the Catholic faith. So, as not to interrupt the longstanding devotional life of the Saint Winifred Church community, we will also be moving the Saint John Neumann Novena from Monday to Wednesday following the 8:45am Mass. This means that each weekday Mass at Saint Winifred will have a unique context: Monday's 5:30pm Mass accommodating our CCD program; Wednesday's 8:45am Mass followed by the traditional Saint John Neumann Novena; and Friday's 8:45am Mass followed by Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction from 9:15am to noon.

Please give the new schedule an opportunity to serve the needs of our two church communities in Saint Paul of the Cross Parish. Following Bishop Zubik's direction for our *On Mission for the Church Alive!* initiative, we are trying to deepen the bonds of catechetical, liturgical, and social community among the people of Saint Paul of the Cross Parish. We need your support and cooperation in the months ahead. The four marks of the Church are: one, holy, catholic, and apostolic. Help us make our merged churches a shining example of these features of the Church universal.

CATECHETICAL SUNDAY

What is Catechetical Sunday and how did it come about?

The third Sunday in September has been set aside as Catechetical Sunday by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Since 1935, the Vatican issued a document asking every country to acknowledge the importance of the Church's teaching ministry and to honor those who serve the Christian community as catechists. On this particular Sunday, those whom the community has designated as catechists will be commissioned to undertake this necessary ministry of the Church. All members of a faith community are reminded of the role they play, by virtue of Baptism, in handing on the treasures of our faith and living as witnesses to the Gospel.

What does the word "catechetical" mean?

Many of us are familiar with the word "catechism;" we may even remember the days of memorizing the Baltimore Catechism. In 1994, Catholics all over the world anticipated the publication of the Catechism of the Catholic Church. This recent text is a compendium of the Church's teachings and is far different from the one we may have memorized in the 1950's and 60's. The root word, "catechesis," comes to us from the Greek word meaning "to echo, or to resound." In this sense, all members of a Christian community are catechists by virtue of our Baptisms which commits each and every one of us to "echo" our faith in Jesus Christ by our words and deeds.

What is the theme for 2019?

A committee of the USCCB chooses a theme for Catechetical Sunday that underlies our teaching efforts for that year. This year's theme may strike us as obvious, yet odd: "Stay With Us." Someone mentioned in passing that this sounds more like a plea than a theme. Perhaps it is both. At this challenging time in our church, this theme may serve as a reflection question: why do we stay in the church? With so many people leaving the Catholic Church, perhaps a good exercise for us would be to reflect and then share with others our reasons for remaining with the Church. We profess the belief that we are the body of Christ; that if one member is hurting, all members are hurting. The body is severely wounded right now; do we stay and try to heal the gaping wound or do we abandon it? Reflecting on our reasons for remaining with the Church may be the best catechesis we "echo" to our children and the world.

We are in great need of TEAM COORDINATORS who schedule the volunteers and help plan for the upcoming host weeks. Each week requires a total of 56 volunteers.

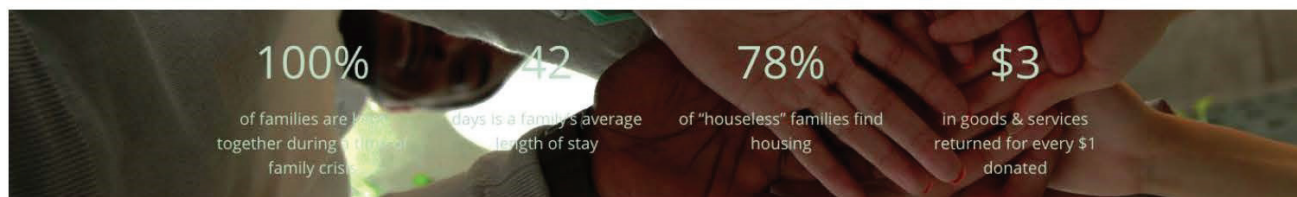

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated on the second and fourth Sundays of each month. A Pre-Baptism class is required with your first child. Please call the parish office for registration and scheduling.

Communion Calls and Visitation of the Sick: Please call the parish office if you or anyone you know would like to receive the Sacraments of Anointing, Confession or Eucharist.

Eucharistic Adoration: Eucharistic Adoration is offered every Tuesday after the 8:00am Mass.
