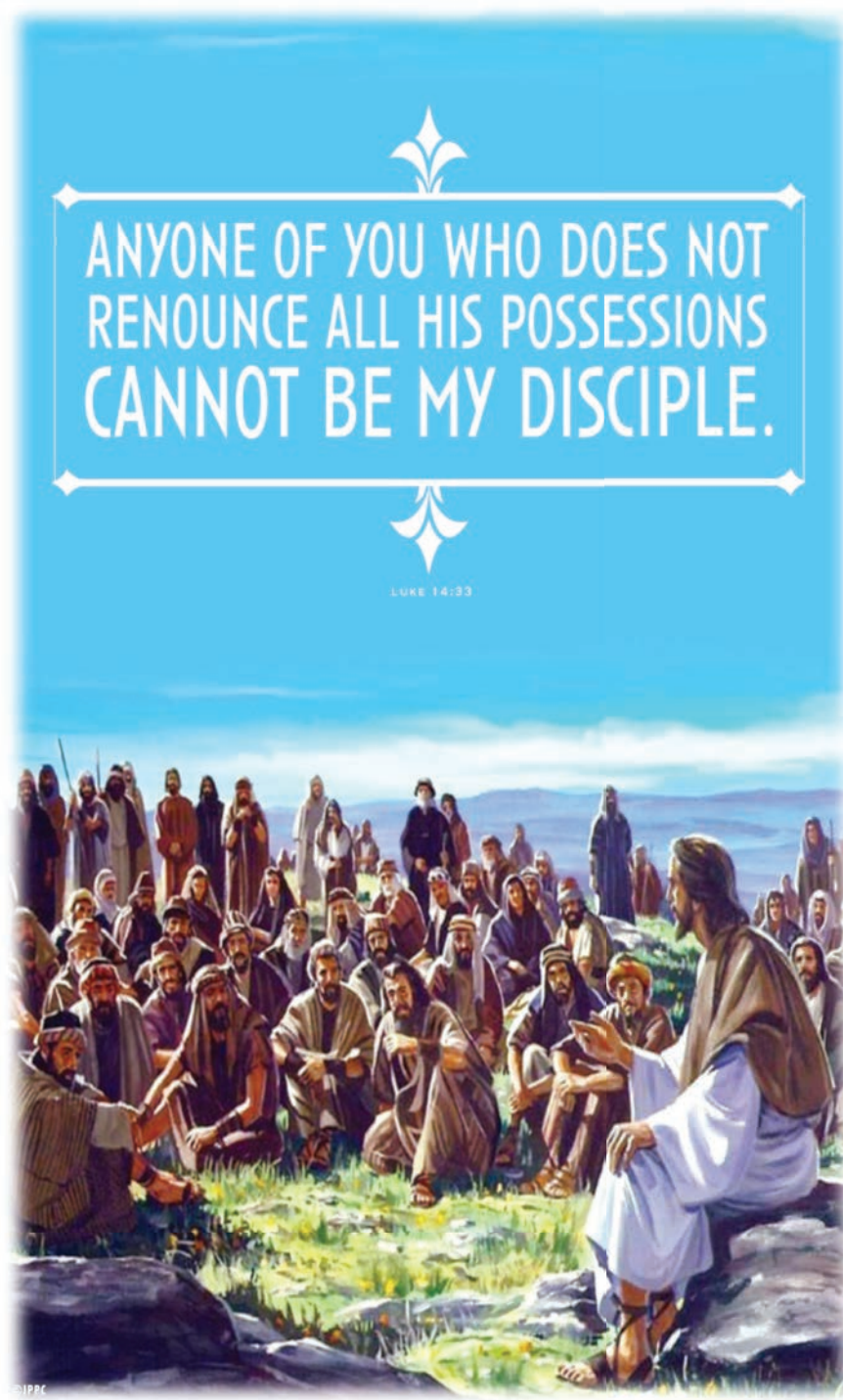

Next Sunday Faith Formation Begins

Now that we are well into September and school has begun, it is time for our Faith Formation (CCD) program to get underway as well, and next Sunday and Monday we will do so.

As the parents of our Faith Formation students know, there are changes to the program this year and I humbly ask everyone's patience and cooperation. One important component of the program will be the inclusion of the kids at Sunday morning (11:30am) or Monday evening (5:30pm) Masses at Saint Winifred's. I know that has caused some understandable consternation in some families, but the goal of having the kids learning to pray better, serve the various ministries of the Mass, and having what they are learning in the classroom directly related to their worship is a worthy one worth trying. I am appreciative to the hard work that our Faith Formation staff has put into designing the new program and I ask everyone's prayers for its success.

Our Sad Times...

Last week we were all saddened to hear the news of the allegation made against Father Bob Cedolia, former pastor of Saint Anne's.

Like the diocesan official who informed me of the allegation and most of you, I doubt the credibility of the accusation. Nevertheless, we are in very strange and sad times and, as a result of the misdeeds of clerics in the past and the well-publicized failures of Church leaders, Father Bob has been placed on leave, made to move and wait for God knows only how long for this mess to be sorted out by the legal system. Please keep him and Father Lang in your daily prayers.

Many have wondered aloud why I didn't address this issue as the Masses last week. The reason why is because many parents in our parish have expressed their uneasiness with matters such as this being discussed in front of their younger children, and I agree with them. Therefore, I've decided that, in general, the best way to communicate concerning topics such as this will be the bulletin. That is also why the Bishop's letter concerning the matter was published in the bulletin and not read from the pulpit.

Further, with the frequency of matters such as this occurring, I think that it's important that at Mass, to the greatest degree possible, we limit our focus to listening to and reflecting upon the Word of God and offering and receiving the saving Sacrifice of Jesus Christ - for these are two things that will always refresh and never disappoint.

The members strive to develop a relationship with God and to know the "why" behind what they believe. The Little Flower Movement was founded on the teachings of St. Therese of Lisieux who pursued a relationship with Christ in "Little ways" everyday. She is often referred to as the "Little Flower".

The Little Flower movement meets weekly on Tuesday at St. Anne Parish in Castle Shannon after the 6:30 Saint Anne Novena Mass at 7:15pm in Harkins Hall. We will study topics like the teachings of St. Therese, the story of Our Lady of Lourdes, finding peace in the mess of life, Divine Mercy, Theology of the Body, and many more!

How to get people to RCIA and be Catholic

When St. Paul went on his missionary journey, he found that Churches had already been established. This means that it wasn't necessarily the Apostles that were the evangelizers but everyday people like you and me. Let's be honest, *it's hard to convince someone to be Catholic let alone invite a non-Catholic to Mass.* Evangelizing is hard and once you have convinced someone to come to Mass and they are getting interested in maybe becoming Catholic RCIA is a daunting experience of preparation and discernment. Part of the problem is that often times we do not have a good road map for Evangelization.

A road map to evangelization is a lot like the parts of a house.

The Foyer

A lot of times when we think of getting people to come to the Church we want them to dive deep into the mysteries, like the Mass. However, most people who are unfamiliar with the Mass find it very difficult to dive right in. There needs to be a foyer. Evangelization has to have an entry point, something accessible, and gives a preview of what one is to expect. These are the things to invite people to get started. Our Church has some foyer opportunities coming up. It might be a good idea to invite and pay for someone to come participate in our concert series, Blood Drive, or Fall Fitness Walk/Run.

The Living Room

As people get more comfortable it's time to move them beyond the foyer and into the living room. Living rooms are meant to have conversations. They are meant to a continuation of getting to know each other. For St. Paul of the Cross, our getting to know you spaces are our awesome faith formation classes (conducted by yours truly) and our RCIA program (conducted by our wonderful RCIA team). These are places where we can show people who are interested in being Catholic can find out more.

The Kitchen

When I was growing up, my friends all had a key to my house and raided our pantry and refrigerator frequently. My mom would get frustrated because they would always eat our tortillas. The Kitchen is where you have your intimate relationships. The Kitchen is for family. At the Kitchen you share food with those who you love and is the culmination of a relationship. The Mass is our kitchen. The Mass is where we share the food of our Lord with people who have become our family.

The Goal of Evangelization is to get people from the foyer to the kitchen. So let's invite people into our foyer, have them get to know us in the living room, and have them be part of our Catholic Family in the Kitchen.

Less than a week remains until the September 11 concert by the Choir of the College of Gonville and Caius at St. Anne Church at 7:30 P.M. The concert has received promotion in the Pittsburgh Catholic and Post Gazette in the past few weeks, and tickets are selling fast. Tickets will be on sale after all Masses this weekend, as well as during office hours during the week, and before the concert. I hope you can join us for this special evening to benefit our organ restoration.

Speaking of the organ renovation, work has begun on the first phase of the project. A contract was finalized with Luley and Associates to complete the first of four phases in mid July. That phase includes a new custom-built organ console with preparations made to accommodate the renovated organ. That should be completed and installed early next year. In the mean time we continue to raise funds to put towards the second phase of the project. The second phase will cost \$81,000, and will include the removal of the nonfunctional parts of the organ, and the renovation of the Great and Pedal divisions.

Fall also brings the start of choir season. We are currently searching for new members for both our Adult Choir, and Children's Choir. The Adult Choir will begin rehearsal on Thursday September 12 at 7:00 P.M. in the Choir Room at St. Winifred Church. The Choir will sing for the first time at Mass on September 15 at 11:30 at St. Winifred. This Mass will be the official kick-off to the Faith Formation Year. The choir will alternate between the 10:00 A.M. Mass at St. Anne, and the 11:30 Mass at St. Winifred throughout the year. The Children's Choir is open to all children in grades 3-8. Rehearsals will be held every other Thursday from 4:30 P.M. to 5:30 P.M. at St. Anne. The choir will sing on the second Sunday of each month at either the 10:00 A.M. Mass at St. Anne or the 11:30 Mass at St. Winifred.
