FROM FATHER RICHARD

Saint Paul of the Cross

Last Sunday following the 6pm Mass at Saint Anne Church, we welcomed Fr. Justin Kerber, CP, Rector for the Passionist Community at Saint Paul of the Cross Monastery on the South Side, to speak to us about the founder of his order from whom we derive the name of our newly merged parish. Fr. Justin Kerber, CP, a noted historian on the life of Saint Paul of the Cross, has been a Passionist priest for 46 years and has served in leadership capacities in the order in both North Carolina and New York before returning to Pittsburgh. As Rector, he has undertaken the task of remodeling their beautiful church and retreat center where parishioners from both Saint Anne and Saint Winifred regularly attend retreats. Following are some of the highlights from Fr. Justin's presentation:

Saint Paul of the Cross (Paul Daneo) was born in Ovada, Italy on January 3, 1694, the eldest child in their large family. His father often read to his children from the lives of the saints, while his mother often consoled her children by pointing to the crucifix and explaining how Jesus suffered for them. In 1720, Paul received a vision of the Blessed Mother Mary clothed in a black tunic and wearing the Passionist symbol. In the apparition, she told him to father companions to establish a new religious order in the Church that would mourn the death of her son, Jesus Christ. With God's guidance, Paul founded the Congregation of the Passion (CP) whose primary purpose is to meditate on and proclaim the Passion of Jesus as the greatest sign of God's love. For the same purpose, he also founded the Passionist Nuns as a contemplative community of women. Paul was a tireless preacher in the towns and villages of Italy. He is recognized as one of the greatest mystics of the 18th century, a model of prayer, penance, and spiritual direction. Paul died in Rome on October 8, 1775; his relics are enshrined in the Basilica of Saints John and Paul in Rome. He was canonized on June 29, 1867, and his feast day is celebrated on October 20 in the United States.

Fr. Justin noted that Pittsburgh was the first Passionist monastery established in the New World at the invitation of Bishop John O'Connor. Please note the portrait of Saint Paul of the Cross now hanging on the wall in both Saint Anne and Saint Winifred Churches. Fr. Justin's informative presentation was a good opportunity for our parishioners to familiarize themselves with the life, work, and legacy of the new patron of our parish. The Passionist priests were the initial evangelizers of the faith in many of the parishes in the South Hills in the late 19th century, including Saint Anne's.

WHY PRE-CANA

Why Pre-Cana marriage preparation?

We've all seen good marriages and we've seen marriages that can use a little work. One of the most important keys to a happy and healthy marriage is to see marriage as an image of God's love.

While a lot of people see diocesan required classes as another hoop to jump through in order to get married, the root of Pre-Cana and Marriage preparation is to help cast a vision of how Marriage should be filled with grace, love, and passion. Pre-Cana casts a vision that helps us see our Marriages as an opportunity to show God's love for all humanity.

Pre-Cana casts a vision where the love between a husband and wife acts as an image of Christ and the Church.

Although marriage is often messy, hard, and takes a lot of work, ultimately the faithfulness of a husband and wife through difficulties shows the world how God is faithful to us despite our messiness and difficulties. Marriage is not a move of self-fulfillment where we seek to make ourselves happy through using another person. Marriage is an opportunity to learn that true happiness comes through giving ourselves to another in the same way Christ gives himself for us.

Pre-Cana helps us see our Marriage as an opportunity for God's grace in our lives. Marriage helps us get to heaven.

Before I got married, I did not think I was a very selfish person. Marriage has functioned as an eye opener where I found out exactly how selfish I am. The beauty of marriage is that you find moments of grace and forgiveness that echoes the forgiveness that God offers us on a daily basis. Through my wife's constant forgiveness of my mistakes, I learn more and more about the patience that God has for me despite my selfishness. These moments of trust and vulnerability are moments where I know God better through knowing my wife. Pre-Cana helps us see our spouses as persons through whom we give and receive grace.

A Catholic vision of marriage helps us view the management of our household as stewarding God's gifts for humanity.

Pre-Cana doesn't just cast a vision of marriage through grandiose theology but helps see how every small decision helps us in our relationship with God. How couples spend their money, how they raise their kids, how they communicate, and how they manage their calendar is sometimes a better homily than one you can hear at Church. All we have is a gift from God; Pre-Cana helps us learn to use these gifts wisely.
