## Fasting and Abstinence

### Abstinence - Ages 14 & up

All who are at least 14 years old are obliged

to abstain from eating meat on Ash

Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

### Fast - Ages 18 - 59

All who are 18-59 years old, are obliged

to Fast on Ash Wednesday and

Good Friday. Fasting means one full meal

and two lighter meals per day with no food

in between, except for medical reasons
