- 4. In the first reading (<u>Exodus 17:8-13</u>), why might God have provided aid to Moses' side in the battle?
  - a. Did God love the Israelites more than Amalek's tribe?
  - b. Why would God want Moses to keep his hands raised for hours as a condition for providing this aid?
- 5. What do you pray most persistently about?
- 6. In your experience is God more likely to answer your prayers if you are persistent? If not, why would Jesus recommend persistence?
- 7. Are answered prayers a sign that God loves you and cares about you?
- 8. When your prayers have gone unanswered, have you ever concluded God didn't care about you? Or that you weren't one of God's favorites?
- 9. Why does God want you to pray? What other benefits are there to prayer besides potentially getting something you want?
- 10. Does God love people who pray more than people who don't?
