Do as He Did - Week 1 April 20 – Easter Sunday

- 1. What stood out the most for you in your celebration of Holy Week?
- 2. Read this week's Gospel (<u>John 20:1-9</u>) about the empty tomb.
 - a. From just this passage How do each of the visitors (Mary, Peter, the beloved disciple) react to the empty tomb? Why?
 - b. The beloved disciple "saw and believed," yet did not understand that Jesus "had to rise from the dead." In your experience, which usually comes first belief or understanding?
- 3. Is there any crisis in your life or painful memory that you would like severed so you could lead a more productive or happier life? Why or why not?
- 4. For the disciples, what lingering memories of Jesus' arrest, passion and death might have stood out or held them back?
- 5. How did the Holy Spirit transform their pain and suffering, rather than severing it?
- 6. Can you share a time when God transformed any messy situation, crisis, or painful memory in your life in a way you originally could not envision? Did God change the situation, change your reaction to it, or somehow use that experience to help you grow?
- 7. Is anything impossible for God? If yes, what? If not, why can the world still look so broken despite Jesus' resurrection?
- 8. How does Jesus' resurrection change, inspire, or fuel you to be more like Jesus and do as he did?
