## Do as He Did - Week 2 April 27 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter

- 1. Have you ever been to Lourdes, another place known for healing, or a healing prayer service? What was your experience like? Were people healed?
- 2. Read the first reading (<u>Acts 5:12-16</u>) where the apostles heal.
  - a. Were the apostles less successful / similarly effective / more successful healers than Jesus? Why?
  - b. Why would God have given the power of healing to the apostles?
  - c. Does God give this power to modern day disciples? In what way?
- 3. Why does God allow sickness? Why aren't all who ask cured?
- 4. "Few people are cured, but healing is offered to everyone." How does God heal in other ways than just curing ailments?
- 5. Fr. Kennedy said that miracles 1) witness to Jesus' connection to God. 2) are a Sign of God's presence, and 3) reveal how God's loving care extends to those thought to be unworthy of God's concern. Describe how that pattern is shown in a memorable gospel or modern-day miracle.
- 6. Describe a time when Pope Francis' actions demonstrated the pattern of witness/sign/reveal in his ministry?
- 7. If disciples are called to do as Jesus did, how can **you** be an active participant in offering healing? Who specifically might need **your** help and prayers today? If you don't feel qualified, what seems to be lacking?
