- 1. If you were able to see any of the coverage of Pope Leo XIV, what struck you about his initial remarks and the priorities he laid out?
- 2. Is there a lesson you learned from your mother, godmother, or grandmother that you try to live out every day?
- 3. Read the first reading (<u>Acts 13:14, 43-52</u>) where Paul and Barnabas turn rejection into success.
 - a. Why were the Jewish leaders so resistant to Paul's message? Why would God have not urged Paul and Barnabas to just keep trying harder to convince the Jews of the importance of Jesus?
 - b. Has God ever helped you adjust your plans, so they became more successful? How?
- 4. What is your reaction to being called to be a missionary proclaiming Christ to the world? In what ways are you already doing this? In what ways could you begin or renew these efforts?
- 5. In general, is the circle of people you interact with growing or shrinking? Do you regularly meet new people and form relationships with them? Or are you losing touch with people you used to be close with?
- 6. If you don't interact with people who don't yet know Jesus or who are unchurched, where might you find them?
- 7. Did you have a meal with anyone last week? How did it go? Were they from your existing circle or someone you didn't know very well?
- 8. What steps could you take this week to be Jesus' hands and feet?
