WHAT: We're changing dates and name for this new fall fundraising event. The St. Francis Fun Run will have it's inaugural year in 2023. This year we are fundraising for some learning supplies for our students. These supplies include: classroom whiteboards as well as tables and chairs for the hallways, that are heavily utilized for small group learning.

PLEDGE PERIOD: Monday, September 25th to Monday, October 9th

WHEN: Friday, October 6th starting at 10 am

WHO: Each student is asked to raise \$50 or more.

HOW: The 2023 Fun Run will be cashless. When gathering donations, simply scan the QR code with a phone or go to the Fun Run website to gather donations.

PRIZES: For each of the 2 weeks of pledge gathering, the top pledge earner for elementary grades (pre-k to 4th) and middle school (5th-8th) will win a prize.

At the conclusion of the 2 weeks of pledge gathering, the top ten pledge earners for the entire school will earn a pizza lunch with the teacher of their choice and Ms. Gonzalez. The 10 winners will also win 1 free dress pass.

If your child does not want to dress up in a costume, they need to be in uniform.

All School Costume Guidelines

- 1. No blood, gore or weapons.
- 2. students may not wear anything suggestive or seductive. Students may not show a bare midriff; tummy; torso, including cleavage; and any dress with narrow straps that exposes the shoulders.
- 3. Full-face Halloween masks can be brought to show but not worn in class.
- 4. Hair color: if the costume includes dying the hair, it must be done at home. It may not be done at school. It also must be completely removed before coming back to school.
- 5. Props (baskets, wands, stuffed animals) may be carried during the parade, but must be put away during class.
- 6. Costumes should be worn to school in the morning. Please make sure students can sit in the costume comfortably.
- 7. Appropriate shoes that students can walk in all day.
- 8. Little ones must be able to remove costume by themselves to use the restroom.
