A quick reminder on commitments:

- <u>Classroom Donations:</u> Each family is required to donate an item worth a minimum of \$25 (or \$25 cash) toward their child's classroom showcase. <u>If a family has more than one child they will donate to each child's showcase.</u> There is a "Showcase Chair" for each grade who is organizing a "Classroom Showcase" by soliciting idea and donations.
- <u>Family Donations:</u> Each family is required to donate a relevant item/package or component of a package worth a minimum of \$100 to the general silent/live auction. To help with this, the auction committee proved basket ideas at last week's car line (suggested themes and contents for gift baskets). Baskets are not required. Families can donate anything that has at least a \$100 value (tickets to sporting events, wine tasting experiences, vacation rentals, etc.) This is in addition to the classroom donation.




