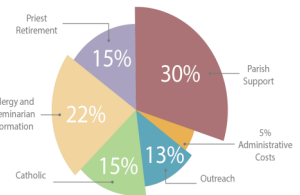

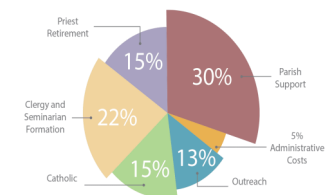

LENT

FAST, PRAY, AND
REPENT.

Lent is a 40-day period of reflection, repentance, and renewal leading up to Easter. Many Christians observe Lent through the practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.



BENDECIDO

CUARESMA

AYUNA, ORA Y
ARREPIÉNTETE.

La Cuaresma es un período de 40 días de reflexión, arrepentimiento y renovación que culmina con la Pascua. Muchos cristianos celebran la Cuaresma mediante la práctica de la oración, el ayuno y la limosna.

HERE ARE SOME SUGGESTIONS FOR HOW YOU CAN PREPARE FOR AND OBSERVE LENT:

PRAYER

- Pray more (Rosary, Stations of the Cross, Liturgy of the Hours).
- Read the Bible or reflect on the Gospel of the day.
- Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
- Attend Mass on weekdays if possible.
- Offer sacrifices in prayer for others.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE (OBLIGATORY) VOLUNTARY FOOD SACRIFICES.

- Fasting: It is practiced on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (one large meal and two small meals).
- Abstinence: No meat on Fridays of Lent.
- Giving up bread, tortillas or flour.
- Giving up sweets, desserts or sugar.
- Not drinking coffee, soft drinks or alcohol.
- Eat without salt or strong seasonings.
- Avoid dairy products or eggs.
- Eat smaller or simpler portions.
- Opt for a simpler diet, such as only fruits and vegetables on certain days.
- Eat only natural foods, avoiding processed foods.
- Prepare more austere meals, without elaborate sauces or stews.
- Make a fasting day with only water or natural juices.

ALMSGIVING / SACRIFICES

- Getting up early to pray.
- Using uncomfortable seats instead of armchairs.
- Walking short distances instead of using the car.
- No heating or air conditioning.
- Sleeping without a pillow or on the floor.
- Avoid Tv, reduce the use of cell phones and social networks.
- Listen only to religious music or keep silent.
- Bathe with cold water or avoid long baths.
- Eating without distractions.
- Fighting Sins and Bad Habits.
- Control anger, impatience and criticism.
- Forgiveness and Reconciliation, pray for those who have hurt us.
- Avoid arguments and confrontations.
- Ask forgiveness when we fail.
- Listen more, talk less.

ORACIÓN

- Orar más (Rosario, Vía Crucis, Liturgia de las Horas).
- Lea la Biblia o reflexione sobre el Evangelio del día.
- Adoración al Santísimo Sacramento.
- Asistir a una misa los días de semana si es posible.
- Ofrecer sacrificios en oración por los demás.

AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA (OBLIGATORIO) SACRIFICIOS VOLUNTARIOS DE ALIMENTOS.

- Ayuno: Se practica el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo (una gran comida y dos pequeñas comidas).
- Abstinencia: No comer carne los viernes de Cuaresma.
- Renunciar al pan, a las tortillas o a la harina.
- Renunciar a los dulces, postres o azúcar.
- No beber café, refrescos ni alcohol.
- Comer sin sal ni condimentos fuertes.
- Evite los productos lácteos y los huevos.
- Coma porciones más pequeñas o más sencillas.
- Opte por una dieta más sencilla, como sólo frutas y verduras en determinados días.
- Consuma sólo alimentos naturales, evitando los alimentos procesados.
- Preparar comidas más austeras, sin salsas ni guisos elaborados.
- Haz un día de ayuno con sólo agua o jugos naturales.

LIMOSNA / SACRIFICIOS

- Levantarse temprano para orar.
- Utilizar asientos incómodos en lugar de sillones.
- Caminar distancias cortas en lugar de utilizar el coche.
- Sin calefacción ni aire acondicionado.
- Dormir sin almohada o en el suelo.
- Evitar la televisión, reducir el uso del celular y redes sociales.
- Escuche sólo música religiosa o guarde silencio.
- Báñese con agua fría o evite baños prolongados.
- Comer sin distracciones.
- Luchando contra los pecados y los malos hábitos.
- Controle la ira, la impaciencia y la crítica.
- Perdón y Reconciliación, oremos por aquellos que nos han hecho daño.
- Evite discusiones y confrontaciones.
- Pedir perdón cuando fallamos.
- Escucha más, habla menos.

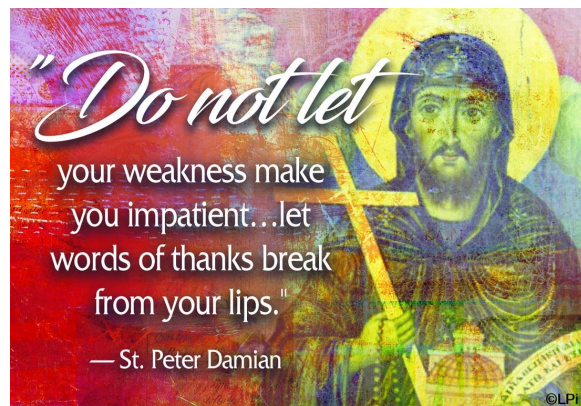

Jer 17:5-8 | 1 Cor 15:12, 16-20 | Lk 6:17, 20-26

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

"It is so good to be poor, to have nothing, to await all from God!" These sentiments of the humble French religious sister St. Jeanne Jugan sum up the spirit of Jesus' words in today's Gospel. Jesus praises poverty, hunger, sadness, and rejection, but certainly not as ends in themselves; God does not take pleasure in our suffering! He does use our suffering, however, to awaken us to our need for him. Poverty can spur us to pursue *heavenly* goods, and thus Jesus assures the poor, "the kingdom of God is yours." Hunger can cause us to seek God who alone can truly satiate our desires, and thus Jesus says to the hungry, "you will be satisfied." Those who weep will laugh, Jesus says – so long as their sadness inspires them to seek happiness in the service of God and the joys of eternal life. For all of us, no matter our means or our circumstances, today's Gospel is a reminder to allow everything – including our difficulties, disappointments, and unfulfilled desires – to turn our hearts to God and rely on his loving care.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

It can be difficult to practice the spirit of the Beatitudes (as the "blessings" in today's Gospel are called) in the moment. Suffering, distress, and confusion easily divert our attention from God as we attempt to "make the problem go away." Sometimes we are even tempted to give up, to turn aside from God, and to seek consolation in other things. This is exactly the opposite of what he wants for us, and for good reason! God knows that it is best for us to always rely on him. This is why, as today's first reading explains, the man who trusts in the Lord is secure – "like a tree planted beside the waters ... it fears not the heat when it comes" – and fruitful – "its leaves stay green." For those who trust in the Lord, help comes from the all-powerful, infinitely loving Creator of the universe. When we entrust ourselves to him, we have nothing to fear.

ACCOMPANY

Is there someone in your life who is struggling with fear, loneliness, anxiety, or sadness? Take time to pray with that person and, together, try to discover God's invitation to a deeper reliance on him in the midst of the distress. These moments of suffering are never occasions for us to get "preachy." Instead, accompany your friend and be a reminder of the hope we have in God.

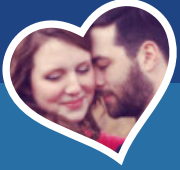
