There is a beautiful, quite small bluestone church at the western (Spencer St.) end of Bourke St, in Melbourne's CBD. Over the years, it has been a popular venue for weddings and the daily lunchtime Masses have proved popular with city workers.

It has also been the location for the last Mass to be celebrated in Melbourne each Sunday - 9.00 pm. And for many years, among the relatively small but devout attendees, was Bert Newton.

Bert's Funeral Mass on Friday was at the other (eastern) end of Bourke St., at St Patrick's Cathedral. Although the COVID-restricted attendance was far less than the Cathedral's usual capacity of nearly 3,000, there is



no question that innumerable people would have attended had that been possible.

But it's the image of Bert finding a seat among 50 or so people in the quiet of St Augustine's Church that is probably closest to the true character of the man who brought entertainment, and especially laughs, to generations of Australians.

Bert's deep faith was an integral part of who he was - as a family man and "Show Biz personality extraordinaire" - but also as a good, caring and loving human being, who found his strength, guidance, inspiration and, when needed, consolation in his personal relationship with God.

His Funeral Mass, perhaps quite fittingly, was attended by many extremely well-known people whose love and admiration for Bert reflected similar sentiments from countless others. But his love of Patti, his children and grandchildren and his deeply appreciated generosity to so many provided a connection with us all.

God gave Bert an extraordinary gift of helping people to laugh. How important that is at any time but especially in these difficult times in which we now live, and the "re- runs" we have seen in the past couple of weeks have reminded us of how much he has given us, especially at those times when we needed a laugh more than anything else.

Perhaps that might be a reminder of how important laughter is for each of us, and how we should appreciate those who, like Bert, have the gift of making us laugh. They don't have to be professional comics. Just people who can "push the button" of laughter, in our family, in our workplaces, neighbourhoods and social groups, especially just when we need it most.



Thank you, Bert for all you have given to So many of us over so many decades. Praying for "eternal rest" somehow doesn't seem to fit. Perhaps we can pray for everlasting inner peace and true, God-given happiness.

Due to additional Victorian State Government regulations, the check-in process can be quite lengthy. Please ensure you arrive at least 20 mins prior to your Mass booking. If possible, please link your Medicare Vaccination Certificate to your VIC GOV check-in app before arriving. This will enable you to come into the church via an "express lane" through the door down the ramp (nearest the school) for quicker entry to Mass.



## November 14 2021 - 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Gospel

### First reading

#### Daniel 12:1-3

Mark 13:24-32

'At that time Michael will stand up, the great prince who mounts guard over your people. There is going to be a time of great distress. unparalleled since nations first came into existence. When that time comes, your own people will be spared, all those whose names are found written in the Book. Of those who lie sleeping in the dust of the earth many will awake. some to everlasting life, some to shame and everlasting disgrace. The learned will shine as brightly as the vault of heaven, and those who have instructed many in virtue, as bright as stars for all eternity.'

### Second reading

### Hebrews 10:11-14,18

All the priests stand at their duties every day, offering over and over again the same sacrifices which are quite incapable of taking sins away. He, on the other hand, has offered one single sacrifice for sins, and then taken his place forever, at the right hand of God, where he is now waiting until his enemies are made into a footstool for him. By virtue of that one single offering, he has achieved the eternal perfection of all whom he is sanctifying. When all sins have been forgiven, there can be no more sin offerings.

Jesus said to his disciples: 'In those days, after the time of distress, the sun will be darkened, the moon will lose its brightness, the stars will come falling from heaven and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory; then too he will send the angels to gather his chosen from the four winds, from the ends of the world to the ends of heaven.

'Take the fig tree as a parable: as soon as its twigs grow supple and its leaves come out, you know that summer is near. So with you when you see these things happening: know that he is near, at the very gates. I tell you solemnly, before this generation has passed away all these things will have taken place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

'But as for that day or hour, nobody knows it, neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son; no one but the Father.'
