This weekend throughout the Diocese we are conducting our annual Catholic Charities Appeal. On behalf of all those who will be served by your generosity, thank you!

On the last Monday of each month we've been holding a joint meeting of both Parish Councils. You may wonder why, if we are 2 separate parishes, are the Parish Councils meeting jointly? That's a good question! And the answer is that meeting together helps to save time and increase communication between the two parishes, especially when we are discussing issues that may have an impact on both parishes. We begin our meetings by praying together, we discuss any common business, and then we break off into individual parish councils for discussion on business unique to each parish. The joint meeting format has been very beneficial so far, it has saved me time, and has helped us to support each other as we continue along our journey.

In our December meeting, soon after Christmas, we held a joint discussion regarding the upcoming Lenten season. We also discussed the Soup Supper & Faith Discussion traditionally held every Lent @ St. Patrick's. Another upcoming event that we wanted to draw your attention too is our Year-Long Parish Mission. We're calling it a Year-Long Parish Mission because it will begin this Lent & end next Lent, but don't worry, it won't require a year-long commitment to attend. 
