Dear Parish Families,

I can not do this and I would not want to do this on my own. Over the year and a half approximately that I have been here, one group, or better yet, two groups that have been invaluable to me in the task of leading and guiding both parish families have been each parishes Parish Pastoral Council, or PPC. For a time during the pandemic, we met via Zoom, but for the most part we have met in person on a monthly basis except for a few months during the summer, to pray, share, and discuss our plans, goals, and vision for parish life.

I wanted to take the opportunity here to share with you some of what we have discussed over the past few meetings. Both PPC's meet on the same evening. The purpose for doing this is not a move towards combining parishes, but simply saving me a meeting night and allowing me to easily communicate with both councils.

We start by praying together and if there is anything that I need to update or discuss with both parishes, we do it at that point. After the joint part of the meeting, which may be long or short depending on what needs to be discussed, we split into individual parish councils to discuss individual parish matters. Starting with our October meeting, we began looking at and discussing the book, "Divine Renovation" by Fr. James Mallon. One fruit that came from our discussion of the introduction and first chapter is to begin to look at starting a program such as "Alpha" or "The Great Adventure Bible Timeline" at either parish. To start, these may be done virtually and as things go on and we see where the pandemic leads we hopefully will be able to move towards in person gatherings at some point in time. Watch for more about the possibility of either of these programs as time goes on.

Another challenge, that may not be the right word, that we have been discussing at PPC, has been our plans for the upcoming Christmas Masses. We have discussed thoughts and plans on a way to worship in a safe way. I also am awaiting further instruction and information from the Diocese and Bishop Malesic regarding plans for Christmas Masses across the Diocese. We (all priests) received a memo late last week that we would be receiving a memo early next (this) week. Once I receive that memo and read through it then there will likely be some further discussion that needs to take place before any official and final plans can be shared, including the Mass schedule. I will share

everything with you as soon as I can, but just know that that may be a few weeks. We continue to pray for everyone's health and safety and an end to this pandemic.


