The St. Martin De Pores Center in the Glenville neighborhood provides support, services, & community and during these pandemic days, when people haven't been able to gather in groups, they've also provided meals that have been brought to seniors at their homes. These are certainly not the only services that Catholic Charities provides throughout our Diocese, there are many other ways that our Diocese has attempted to reach out and help the many affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. Again, this isn't it, but these examples help to give us a more concrete idea of where the money that we stick in that envelope goes and who it goes to support.
