Marriages require a six month preparation period by Diocesan policy. Call one of the parish priests prior to setting a date.


Funerals: Arrangements are to be made at the Parish Office before publication of the death notice.

Dear Parish Family,

“This is the song that never ends, yes it goes on and on my friends.” For a while, that may have been what it seemed like regarding the pandemic that we found ourselves in the midst of, that this would never end. But hopefully it is and hopefully we are coming out of this.

Beginning on June 2nd, our celebration of the Liturgy will, in many ways, begin to look like what we've been used to. Here is what you can expect BEGINNING ON JUNE 2ND:

1. Facemasks will NO LONGER be required, but they continue to be strongly suggested for those who have not yet been vaccinated or who are otherwise vulnerable.
2. The signs that have been on the doors of the Church/Parish Office requiring the use of facemasks will be removed and new signs suggesting facemasks for those who meet the above criteria are to be put in their place.
3. Social distancing/the blocking off of every other pew will no longer be required. We are considering keeping one section of pews with every other pew blocked off for those who might want to continue to social distance for the time being so you may find one section of pews still with every other pew blocked off.
4. The Holy Water fonts will be filled again and will be cleaned regularly.
5. We will once again be processing to begin and end Mass. The Offertory Procession with parishioners bringing up the bread and wine will also begin to take place again.
6. The Ushers will return to taking up the collection in the normal way during the Offertory at Mass. The baskets will no longer be at the doors of the church.
7. We are looking at returning to using our Liturgical Ministers (EMHC's, Lectors, Servers). We are reaching out to those who are currently a part of these ministries, but we could use your help as well. If you are interested in learning more about becoming a part of any of these ministries, please let us know.
8. The distribution of the Precious Blood at Mass will remain suspended for the time being.
9. We are able to return the hymnals and other books to the pews so we will again be able to sing together at Mass. The current missalette with the readings in it goes through the weekend of June 5th & 6th. Rather than having volunteers put those out for only 1 weekend, you can look for the song books to return the weekend of June

5th/6th & the missalette with the readings to return as well the weekend of June 12th/13th.

10. The cleaning of the church will continue to take place on a regular basis, but not necessarily after every Mass.

ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY



This cemetery is located in Arlington County, Virginia, across the Potomac River from Washington DC. The cemetery opened on May 13, 1864. Some notable people buried there that are not presidents are: Jackie Cooper, Charles Durning, Joe Louis, Lee Marvin, Audie Murphy and Maureen O'Hara. **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier** has been patrolled continuously, 24/7, since 1930. The guard takes 21 steps across the tomb, does an about face, hesitates for 21 seconds before beginning his return walk (21 alludes to the twenty-one gun salute). The gloves worn by the guard are moistened to prevent losing his grip on the rifle. Guards are changed every 30 minutes. Guards must commit 2 years of life to guard the tomb. The shoes are special made with very thick soles to keep heat and cold from their feet. There are no wrinkles, folds or lint on the guards uniform. Every guard spends 5 hours a day getting his uniforms ready for guard duty.
