PASCHAL TRIDUUM celebrates the heart of our faith, salvation, and redemption: the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Thus, the Triduum commemorates the Institution of the Eucharist (the "sacrament of sacraments"), the passion, crucifixion, death of the Lord. His descent to the dead, and finally his glorious resurrection on Easter Sunday morning. These important events make up the Paschal Mystery. Holy Week is a time to clear our schedules of unnecessary activities. Let us bear the Cross so that we may be worthy of wearing the crown he wore.

**HOLY THURSDAY** liturgy recalls the Last Supper and the First Eucharist, where Jesus models for us how to serve when he washes the disciples' feet. It also commemorates the establishment of the priesthood.



GOOD FRIDAY is the most sober liturgy of the church year; the altar is completely bare. The Liturgy of the Word is followed by adoration of the cross, and communion. However, there is not Liturgy of the Eucharist—this is not a Mass. We hear the Passion from the Gospel of John. The ac-

count is written from the perspective of the Resurrection. The cross, a symbol of torture and death, has become a symbol of Christ's victory over death, a symbol of glory and life. This is a day of fasting and abstinence.

**HOLY SATURDAY** is the high point of the liturgical year, the Easter Vigil, immerses us in the mystery of death and resurrection, and engages all our senses. We move from darkness to light, from a single voice chanting the Exultet to the triumphant symphony of instruments and voices proclaiming Glory to God and Alleluia! We watch as the catechumens are immersed in the waters of baptism, anointed with Sacred Chrism, and welcomed to the Eucharistic banquet. We share a sign of peace and embrace with those who have joined our church community.

#### DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY —APRIL 16, 2023

Jesus promised Saint Faustina that on Divine Mercy Sunday "The soul who will go to Confession and receives Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. Divine Mercy Sunday devotions will be celebrated at St. Vincent de Paul at 3:00 pm on April 16th. Everyone is urged to attend and participate in this most blessed celebration of our Lord's Mercy. Please note there will be no devotions Sunday, April 2nd.




