Marriages require a six month preparation period by Diocesan policy. Call one of the parish priests prior to setting a date.


Funerals: Arrangements are to be made at the Parish Office before publication of the death notice.

I know and recognize that we'll be navigating some uncertain waters over the upcoming months as I've written and talked about over the past few weeks.
