

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parish Families,

Welcome to the first edition of our Joint Parish Bulletin! I want to thank Fr. Robert for being a guest columnist while I was away. I was able to enjoy a restful week and a half with friends and now we're back into the full swing of activities.

As I shared with each parish the 2 weekends before I headed out on vacation, Bishop Malesic has formally renewed my term as the Pastor of both St. Patrick and St. Vincent de Paul for another 6-year term. I was happy to hear that news as I truly feel at home here. There are, as there always are everywhere, ups and downs, but I am truly blessed to be on this journey with all of you. I can say that it took a few years for me to get my feet underneath me. With learning how to Pastor in general along with a global pandemic arising and my dad's cancer diagnosis and eventual passing all within the first 3 years of my being here, there was an enormous learning curve. I have learned a lot and I have grown a lot. The Pastor that I am now is not the Pastor that I was when I first came here and is, I pray, not the same Pastor that I will be in the upcoming years.

As a part of the renewal process, there is a self-evaluation form that the Bishop asks the Pastor to fill out. Praying with this self-evaluation gave me the opportunity to reflect on where we've been and where we hope to go, looking back and looking ahead. Over my upcoming columns and in some of my homilies as well, I hope to share with you some of the fruits of that prayer.

One of the questions that the self-evaluation asked me is to "dream big" and name 2 or 3 things that, if all practicality were thrown to the wind. I would like to see for the parish in the upcoming 6 years. As I thought and prayed about that question my answers were to enhance our faith formation programs, our outreach ministries, and our parish cooperation (in no particular order). First, I would love to build up a vibrant adult faith formation program, looking for opportunities to help us learn and grow in our faith and deepen our understanding and appreciation of why we do what we do so that we can, in turn, share our faith better in our daily lives. Second, I'd like to work to build up our parish outreach programs.


PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN
