
Through Prayer



6:00 PM


- † Angelus

- V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary,

HAIL MARY...


- V. Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

LET US PRAY

• Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts, that we, to whom the incarnation of Christ Thy Son was made known by the message of an Angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection; through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.



Daily Examination of Conscience



- 1. Place yourself in the presence of God and ask for his help in examining your day.
- 2. Examine your day (the three "words"):
 - "Thank you": Thank the Lord for the blessings of the day.
 - "I'm sorry": Acknowledge your faults specifically and directly.
 - "Please help me more": Ask the Lord for help for tomorrow. Make specific resolutions.
- 3. Make an act of contrition.
- 4. End with an Our Father and a Hail Mary.









CDA Court Monthly Prayer Plan

- Possibly attend Mass or say a rosary before the meeting.
- Open the meeting with a prayer.
- Prayer should be 1/4g of meeting time. Ex. 15 minutes if meeting is an hour.
- Should pray a mix of traditional and spontaneous prayer.
- Have a 5–10-minute prayer talk on a Saint, a Catholic Tradition, a Liturgical Feast, etc.
- Pray before important agenda items.
- Close the meeting with a prayer.
- Pray each time you meet for an activity or Fundraiser.
- Pray for each other during the month. (Secret Prayer Partner)











- 1. Attend a week-long silent retreat.
























Sugar, Sugar by the Archies

And you've got me wanting you!




Resources
