The Pastor's Two Cents

In this weekend's Gospel Jesus points out the two great commandments. "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart,



with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." St. Paul reminds us in his letter to the Corinthians that God's greatest gift is the gift of love. I don't think any of us would dispute that. Love does not always create warm fuzzy feelings in us. Sometimes it can cause us great pain when someone we have loved and who has loved us is called home to God.




