The Pastor's Two Cents

In this weekend's Gospel Jesus points out the two great commandments. "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." St. Paul reminds us in his letter to the Corinthians that God's greatest gift is the gift of love. I don't think any of us would dispute that. Love does not always create warm fuzzy feelings in us. Sometimes it can cause us great pain when someone we have loved and who has loved us is called home to God.

Most people have experienced this pain in life. The pain of loss caused by the death of a parent, spouse or child can seem deep and endless. I believe that it is at those times when we are challenged to remember the greatest commandment; love of God!

Love requires trust. Therefore, love of God requires that we trust God's love for us and place ourselves and those we love in God's capable hands, trusting in the promises of Christ. This is not easy, but God gives us the sacraments and the community of faith to assist us as we try to deal with this pain of loss.

The month of November in the church calendar is characterized as a month of remembrance. The month begins with the Feast of All Saints and is followed on the second of November with the feast of All Souls. On those days we remember the heroes that have gone before us marked by faith. Throughout the month of November I have found it beneficial to remember those people with which God has blessed me on my journey. I try to remember them in prayer and to browse through old pictures and mementos to recall with gratitude the joys that we shared and to thank God for the gift of them and the faith they shared with me.

Each year during this month Our Lady of the Valley Parish has offered a special Mass dedicated to remembering our departed loved ones, especially those whom God has called home from our parish this past year. In past years this has occurred at a regularly scheduled Sunday Mass. However, this year to assure everyone's safety during this time of Covid-19 we will be offering **a special Mass on Saturday, November 7 at noon.**

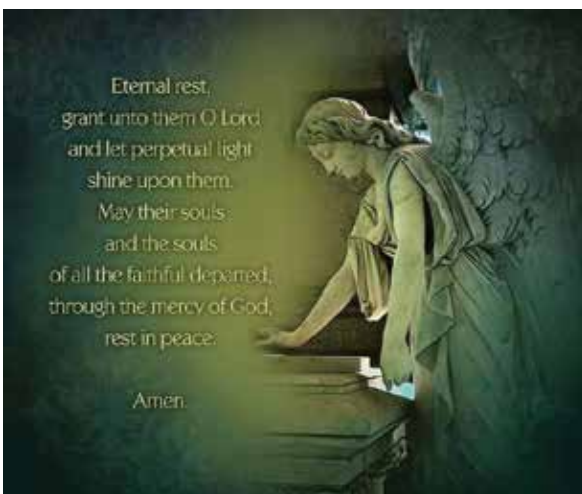

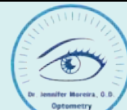
