## The Pastor's Two Cents

***“Cursed is the one... whose heart turns away from the Lord”***

The story is told about a member of a parish church, who previously had been attending Mass regularly, but had recently stopped going. After a few weeks, the pastor decided to visit him on a cold winter evening. The pastor found the man at home alone, sitting in the living room before a blazing fire in the fireplace. The man welcomed the priest and led him to a big chair near the fireplace. The pastor made himself comfortable but said nothing. In the silence, he noticed the play of the flames around the burning logs.



After a few minutes, the pastor took the tongs, and carefully picked up a brightly burning ember and placed it all alone to one side of the hearth. Then he sat back in his chair, still silent. The host watched all this in quiet curiosity. As the one lone ember's glow diminished, there was a momentary glow and soon its glow was no more until it was cold and dead.

Without a word, just before the pastor was ready to leave, he picked up the cold, dead ember and placed it back in the middle of the fire. Immediately it began to glow once more with the light and warmth of the burning coals around it. As the pastor reached the door to leave, his host said, “Father, thank you so much for your visit. I will be back in church next Sunday.”

On January 20, 2020 the CDC confirmed the first U.S. laboratory-confirmed case of COVID-19 in the U.S. Since then I have noticed a decline in attendance at Mass. During this time we began to stream daily Mass on our parish Facebook page and we continued to televise the 10:45 am Mass on Sunday for our shut-ins, thanks to the generosity of Bob Peisher. I know that this has been a blessing for many who are not able or who preferred not to attend Mass during the pandemic, especially those whose immunity is compromised. However, it has not allayed my concern for the spiritual welfare of those who are absent. If our attendance was only about joining in the prayers and hearing the scripture readings and homily (Yes, even at home you cannot sleep through the homily!) then this would work great. However, our presence in church is also about receiving the holy Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ!

I am so glad we are able to stream the Mass for those who are away from home or who must stay home for their health, but in the long term we need more. We each need to be nourished by the Lord's Body and Blood. Just as our bodies need regular physical nourishment, without which we would die; so do we need regular spiritual nourishment lest we die.

It is my hope that with our vaccines available, soon Covid, even with its variants, will become like a flu. Until then we need to remain vigilant about our faith lest we lose our way. For those who fear being in a large crowd, please remember that the 6:45 am Sunday Mass allows plenty of space to distance from others. Our daily Mass at 12:10 pm also does the same. For those who are away or who cannot attend, please be aware of our continued prayers for you. If you are in need of anything, please do not hesitate to call the parish office.

## Sunday Gospel Reflection The Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time February 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup>

**Luke 6:17, 20-26**

### Gospel Summary

Jesus taught his listeners that some values in God's Kingdom will be the opposite of what they are in our earthly society. Those with no power or material possessions, but who trust completely in God will be first in the Kingdom of God. But people who value the luxuries of this world will be last in the Kingdom.

### Reflection for Parents

Children trust their parents to take good care of them and give them direction. That's a lot of responsibility for a parent. Similarly, we all are challenged by these beatitudes to trust completely in God. When we trust and serve God, we know clearly from this reading that God will take care of us in the Kingdom.

### Bringing the Good News Into Your Family

Read the Beatitudes carefully again as a family. Suggest ways that people might be "poor" that don't relate to economic class. What ways can people be hungry and still have enough food to eat? What kind of sorrow would we experience without God in our lives? With a broader understanding of these terms, create a mobile or booklet where family members illustrate what the beatitudes mean for your family today. You might conclude by suggesting ways your family will practice living out the beatitudes you have illustrated.
