### **Immaculate Conception**

The Immaculate Conception is a Catholic dogma that states Mary, the mother of Jesus, was conceived without original sin and she remained without sin throughout her entire life.

The early church fathers found that Scripture readings such as - "Hail, favored one! The Lord is with you", "blessed are you among woman", "All generations will call me blessed". - suggested and implied that she was innocent, most pure, holy and immaculate.



The early saints recognized these terms for example: Irenaeus 140-220, Ephrem 306-373, Ambrose 373-397, Augustine 395-430, Anselm 1023-1109. St. Augustine said that it would be an offense against Jesus to say that His mother was a sinner.

The Eastern Church celebrated the feast of the Immaculate Conception of Mary in the 12th century. The Western Church began the observance of this feast with a papal encyclical by Pope Pius IX, when he formally defined the dogma of the Immaculate Conception, Ineffabilis Deus, on December 8th, 1854. The mere fact Mary bore Jesus Christ in her womb, makes her the greatest of all women. She should be honored and venerated.

Mary's apparition to Bernadette at Lourdes, France, identified herself as the Immaculate Conception.


