Chili Cook Rules and Instructions

- 1) Customers are allowed unlimited tastes. Customers get only 1 taste at a time, but they can return later.
- 2) Tastes should be tastes (~2 oz., not bowls or larger servings). Note: The more people you serve, the more opportunity to get votes.
- 3) Prizes will be based on the number of votes for your chili. Votes via plastic discs will be collected at your booth.
- 4) Booths will be supplied with a 10 x 10 canopy.
- 5) Cooks must supply their own tables, chairs, decorations, etc.....
- 6) Propane heating is encouraged. No electricity is available
- 7) Check-in/setup will start at 6:00 a.m.
- 8) Each Chili Booth location will be assigned at check-in.
- 9) Each Chili Booth will be given event admission for four people. Anyone else must pay to enter the event.
- 10) Chili Cooks must park their vehicles in the Royal High School parking lot across the street after unloading/setting up.
- 11) Have Fun. Keep in mind that this is an event to raise money to support the activities of the Knights of Columbus.
- 12) Event ends at 4:00pm. Your booth must be clear by 5:00.
- 13) No other food items may be served in the booth, just chili. Nothing else.
