June 27, 2021 Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Wisdom 1:13-15; 2:23-24; 2 Corinthians 8:7, 9, 13-15; Mark 5:21-43

"God does not make death, nor does he rejoice in the destruction of the living."

It is absolutely incredible, first of all, to read stories of the carnage some human beings inflict upon others, and secondly, to sense the hopelessness of intervening to stop the death dealing. "The World" looks on in horror—yet that same world seems unable or unwilling to intervene. The killing frenzy continues until, like sharks running out of available targets to kill and consume, it finally ends.

If the writer of Wisdom is correct, then the God we believe in must be aghast, appalled, utterly outraged by what humans sometimes do to one another. For God "fashioned all things that they might have being."

In part, this must be why Jesus was such a powerful agent against sickness and pain and death. He did works of healing until he was totally exhausted. Power to heal went forth from him, and, of course, attracted vast crowds to him.

But the major healing he tried to bring was to the human spirit. that very spirit which from early on was tempted by Satan, gave in and thus brought death into our world.

Jesus did all he could do in his brief life; and then he left to the Church the powers he used so effectively. But our own times tell us the healing of the human spirit still has a long, long way to go.
