

## December 17, 2023 Third Sunday of Advent

Isaiah 61:1-2a, 10-11; 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24; John 1:6-8, 19-28

John the Baptist figures prominently in the gospel of this third Sunday of Advent. Last Sunday he played the same prominent role. This is about the only time of the church year we hear about John. Then he disappears from the scene.

John is the one who tells us to prepare—to get ready for one greater than himself. John does not draw attention to himself, even though we are told great numbers of people came out to hear him and to be baptized by him. But John always spoke of one who was to come after—one "whose sandals I am not even worthy to unfasten."

In all this, John sets an example for us. Our good deeds for the Lord; our telling others about the Lord; should lead others to the Lord and not to ourselves. If others see "Christ in us" that is all good. We should hope that by word and works we would help lead others to know Christ. But it is Christ who works in and through us "To Christ be the honor and the glory," an old saying states.

If we lead others to Christ we imitate the great St. John the Baptist. To do thus should be one of our Advent goals.

Official Archdiocesan Eucharistic Pilgrimage Site - Blessed Sacrament Church in Waterloo Archbishop Zinkula has granted Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church in Waterloo to be an official Eucharistic Pilgrimage Site for the Archdiocese of Dubuque for a six month period from Monday, December 4, 2023 (1st Monday of Advent) through Sunday, June 2, 2024 (Corpus Christi). This is the only church in the archdiocese named for the Blessed Sacrament. More details to come, but the church will be open for all pilgrims to visit from Monday through Friday 8:30am - 9:00pm and Saturday from 8:30am - 4:00pm (just before Mass). Church will be closed outside of Mass on Sunday, unless there are groups who wish to visit and can schedule with the Parish Business Office. Groups can also schedule their own Mass during these times and are welcome to do so. The Eucharist will be exposed during these times for pilgrims to spend in adoration and prayer. Every Thursday, there will be extra opportunities for confession at various times, a Marian prayer group in the afternoon, and healing prayer ministry during the evening. Finally, pilgrims will have an opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence related to the Eucharist for coming to Blessed Sacrament. There are certain conditions that must be fulfilled in order to obtain the indulgence, and more info will be forthcoming. Thank you!
