December 31, 2023 The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph Genesis 15:1-6, 21:1-3; Hebrews 11:8, 11-12, 17-19; Luke 2:22-40

It is most ironic that as we lament the breakdown of the

traditional family in our society, we celebrate a most untraditional family as the source of true and traditional family values. The "family" of Joseph, Mary and Jesus was anything but typical for their day. Mo matter how much of God's intervention we may ascribe to the make up of this threesome, the facts are: Joseph was not the physical father of Jesus, yet took the mother of Jesus to himself as wife. And, furthermore, there was only one child—a rather unusual and even disdainful condition for a family of Israel at that time.

The question is posed, then—what constitutes a true and traditional family, and what family values does such a family have? To look to the "Holy Family" for neat and clear answers to these questions is a mistake.

Joseph. Mary and Jesus are celebrated as the "Holy Family," not because of the particular make up of the relationships, but rather according to how the relationships were lived.

These three lived with each other in deep charity, trust, forgiveness and mutual respect. These qualities are crucial for any family's well-being, no matter what shape it takes.
