Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Numbers 21:4b-9: Philippians 2:6-11: John 3:13-17

*"We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you,
because by your Cross you have redeemed the world."*

In the Book of Numbers (21:4b-9), the people of Israel, weary and discouraged, found healing when they looked upon the bronze serpent lifted up by Moses. This image points us forward to the mystery of the Cross, where true healing and salvation would be revealed. Saint Paul, in his letter to the Philippians (2:6-11), reminds us that though Christ was in the form of God, He emptied Himself, taking on human likeness and embracing even death on a cross. Because of this humble obedience, God exalted Him and gave Him the name above every other name. In the Gospel of John (3:13-17), Jesus ties these two truths together: just as the serpent was lifted up, so too must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that all who believe in Him may have eternal life. For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son—not to condemn the world, but to save it.

These readings invite us to reflect on the paradox of humility and exaltation. To be lifted up is not about earthly power but about surrendering to God's will in love. When we look to Christ on the Cross, we see both the depth of His humility and the height of His glory. It is in this "lifting up" that we find healing, salvation, and hope.

As our Archdiocese engages in the Journey in Faith process, we are reminded that our pastorate models must be rooted in this same scriptural truth. Just as Christ's path was one of self-giving love, our communities are called to embrace servant leadership, unity, and mission. Like the Israelites who found healing by looking up, we too must fix our eyes on Christ and allow His love to shape the structures of our parish life. In doing so, our faith communities can become living witnesses of God's saving love—lifted up, not for our own glory, but for the life of the world.
