Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4; 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14; Luke 17:5-10

*“The word of the Lord remains forever.
This is the word that has been proclaimed to you.”*

This weekend’s readings remind us that faith is not simply a feeling we experience in moments of peace—it is a deep, persevering trust in God even when life feels overwhelming. The prophet Habakkuk cries out to the Lord about injustice, violence, and destruction all around him. He questions, he laments, and yet God answers with a call to patience: the vision still has its time, and the just will live by faith.

St. Paul encourages Timothy to stir into flame the gift of faith he has received, even in the face of fear and hardship. Faith does not take away struggle, but it gives us courage to endure with hope. Jesus, in the Gospel, reminds His disciples that faith—even as small as a mustard seed—can accomplish what seems impossible. But this kind of faith is not about demanding results from God; it is about humble service, living faithfully day by day, trusting that God will act in His time.

Like the disciples, we too cry out, “Increase our faith!” May we remember that faith is both a gift and a practice—nurtured in prayer, strengthened through community, and lived out in our ordinary acts of obedience and love.

When we persevere in faith, even when answers seem slow in coming, we become witnesses of God’s steadfast love to the world. Our trust in Him not only transforms our own hearts but also inspires others to keep going. In times of doubt or struggle, let us cling to this truth: God is faithful, and He never abandons His people.


