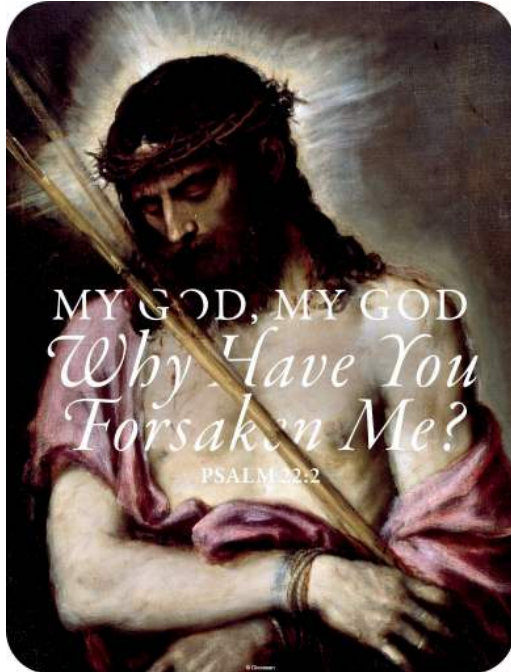

**Wednesday, April 1, 7:30PM**

The Office of Tenebrae, meaning darkness or shadows, has for centuries been a Holy Week devotion. Following the opening prayer, the service is divided into three Nocturns, each with Psalms and each preceded and concluded by an appropriate antiphon. After the Psalm reading, the Lord's Prayer is prayed by the congregation. Then follows the reading of three Lessons, each with versicles and congregational responses. One of the distinguishing features of the service is the extinguishing of the candles and other lights in the church until only a single candle (Christ Candle) symbolizing the Lord's death and burial remains. After the third Nocturn, the service concludes with Psalm 51 and the removal of the Christ Candle for a time. The strepitus is heard (loud noise). The Christ candle is then returned in anticipation of Our Lord's resurrection. At the conclusion of the service, all depart in silence.

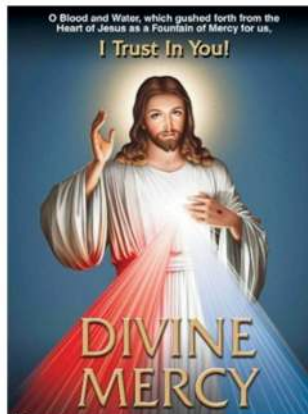



**Saintly Steps with SRRE**  
 Discover a new holy friend every week as we grow in faith together  
**St. Mary of Egypt – Feast Day: April 2**



St. Mary of Egypt lived between 344 and 421. Tradition says she left home at a very young age and spent many years in Alexandria (Egypt) living a deeply sinful life. Her turning point came when she traveled to Jerusalem and found herself unable to enter the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. In that moment, she realized how far she had drifted from God, asked for the Blessed Mother’s help, and experienced a profound conversion.

After that, she crossed into the desert beyond the Jordan and lived for many years as a hermit, spending her life in prayer, repentance, and complete dependence on God.

What makes her stand out is that her story is not about pretending the past did not happen. It is about how God’s mercy can completely change a person. That is why she is remembered as a powerful saint of conversion, healing, and hope for anyone trying to begin again.

It also included questions from Fr. Tom’s book *Who’s Who in Heaven* and a brief reflection on Adoration.
