



Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary August 15th



All the feast days of Mary mark the great mysteries of her life and her part in the work of redemption. The central mystery of her life and person is her divine motherhood, celebrated both at Christmas and a week later (Jan. 1) on the feast of the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. The Immaculate Conception (Dec. 8) marks the preparation for that motherhood, so that she had the fullness of grace from the first moment of her existence, completely untouched by sin.

Her whole being throbbed with divine life from the very beginning, readying her for the exalted role of mother of the Savior. The Assumption completes God's work in her since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over.

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they do not look only to the past. They look to the present and to the future and give us an insight into our own relationship with God. The Assumption looks to eternity and gives us hope that we, too, will follow Our Lady when our life is ended. The prayer for the feast reads: "All-powerful and ever-living God: You raised the sinless Virgin Mary, mother of your Son, body and soul, to the glory of heaven. May we see heaven as our final goal and come to share her glory."

In 1950, in the Apostolic Constitution < Munificentissimus Deus>, Pope Pius XII proclaimed the Assumption of Mary a dogma of the Catholic Church in these words: "The Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heaven."

With that, an ancient belief became Catholic doctrine and the Assumption was declared a truth revealed by God.

Our praesidium meeting should not be like other meetings. It is sacred to us. It is the lifeblood of the Legion. Mary is present there. We want to make it nice just like we were meeting at Mary's house. Clean, orderly, that we arrive on time. There we gather as brothers and sisters under one Father God and under one mother Mary. Just imagine Nazareth, Mary Joseph and Jesus. They knew Jesus would go out to change the world, to save the world but this gave glory to God: their charity, their living together for 30 years. Jesus shows his humility and submission.

You in the Legion have to be sure to truly love each other, to not gossip, to not have envy, to not always be defensive. To be a leader who leads by example. The greatest among you must be the servant of all. You have to not be so protective of your position.

There is a book Fr. Elijah and the Pope himself is slapped by a Cardinal. The Pope offers it up.

As Leaders we have to lead and not be overly offended or protective of your authority. Your authority is not about you but about order and the good of the Legion. So if someone is being disobedient. You must come to them because they are not being like Jesus or Mary. Don't approach them out of wounded pride. You have to approach them out of the good for the Legion. And always you can go to the pastor.

The Legion is the extension of the priest. Does your priest know you are there for him that you are a link in the chain between the him and the people who you can minister to? Let him know you are there for his apostolic needs, his apostolic zeal. See if there is a way your priest could commit to coming once a month to the meetings? Is there a day you meet on that is better for him?

We have to bring the joy of Mary, the joy of the Mystical home at Nazareth to all people, to families where there is no spirit of prayer, no supernatural faith. We have to bring that supernatural faith to them. The Rosary, The Enthronement of the Sacred Heart, the pilgrim virgin. Mary can use that prayer in the home to leave a lasting impression on people's souls.

As Legionaries we go to people and one on one encounter people. Don't be afraid to talk about religion. "That condition of religious deaf-muteness must be jolted and educated out of itself. Those who do not want to talk religion must have religion talked to them."

We have to help people think about their lives about God's will for them, about where they come from about Jesus, Mary and the Church and Sacraments.

We have to have apostolic fervor, but it all starts with the officers and spreads down. The officers need to be praying every day, filled with God's love, to truly be like Mary full of God's love and showing God's love to others.

Ten years later the society was introduced in the United States by a priest who had seen the work of the group in Dublin and was impressed. This resulted in organization of a legion by seven men in Raton, New Mexico.




