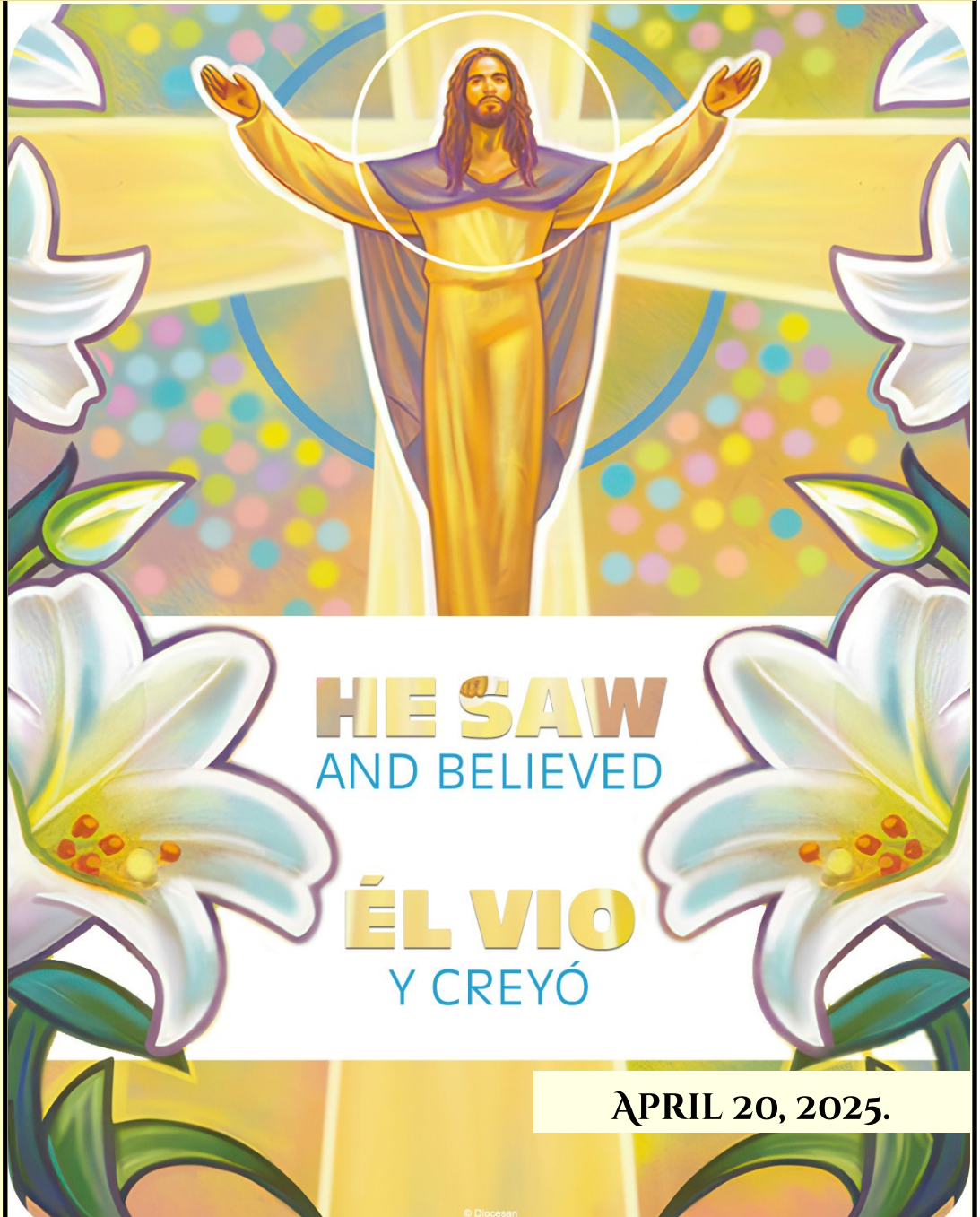

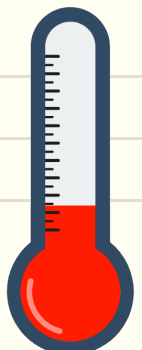

# Happy Easter!

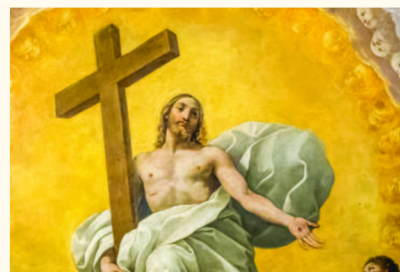
***“Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests.”***

Those words were spoken by a multitude of angels at the birth of the Christ Child. There was such joy in anticipation for what Jesus would one day do. He would save the world. And now everything has been fulfilled. He has witnessed to the love of God by his miracles, his words, his sufferings and his death. Can any of us truly understand the love of Jesus Christ? The love he had for his Father that humbled him to take on flesh.

We must learn to love one another. And quite honestly, the only way it can be possible is if we heed his words,

***“Love one another as I have loved you.” (Jn 13:13)***

Whenever we love, we should love for the sake of Jesus. Then our love will be perfect. And our love will humble us to do what is honorable for others. I just came from a nursing home and celebrated an early Easter Mass for them. And quite frankly, there was such holiness present that it caused me to shutter. These individuals were so honorable. And in spite of their sufferings, they haven't lost their faith.



I asked them many deep questions about Holy Week. And shockingly, they knew all the answers. Spoken from their wheelchairs. There was one deformed man, who seemed to be sleeping the whole time. His suffering, his cross was so great. He had sores all on his body. I felt ashamed of my own foolish complaints about life. When it came time for the 'Lord's Prayer', he started speaking. He said the Lord's Prayer from start to finish. I had underestimated him. My love for Jesus caused me to humble myself and to kneel on the floor next to him. From the floor, I gave him Holy Communion. He smiled. I cried.

I briefly understood Jesus Christ. His love for the Father caused him to humble himself to stoop down to the level of humanity and to give us His Body and Blood. Jesus Christ must be loved especially. He alone, above all others in the world, is our good and faithful friend. Because of him, let all men and women be special to you. Whether they be your friend or handicapped or your enemy, pray to Jesus for them. Pray that all people will come to know Jesus and to love him. Then there will be peace on earth. And as a true Saint, don't ever yearn for the special love or praise that belongs to God alone. So many musicians and actors and sports players receive too much love and praise that only God deserves. And they never point to Jesus Christ. They become idols. God has no peer.

Let Jesus be within you and in every person to whom his favor rests. This is our prayer. This is our hope that all may be saved by his precious blood.

**Blessed be the Name of Jesus! Now and Forever!**

# ¡Feliz Pascua!

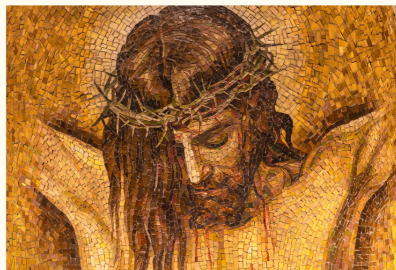
***“Gloria a Dios en las alturas, y en la tierra paz a los hombres en quienes él se complace.”***

Esas palabras fueron pronunciadas por una multitud de ángeles al nacer el Niño Jesús. Había una gran alegría anticipando lo que Jesús haría un día. Salvaría al mundo. Y ahora todo se ha cumplido. Ha dado testimonio del amor de Dios con sus milagros, sus palabras, sus sufrimientos y su muerte. ¿Acaso podemos comprender verdaderamente el amor de Jesucristo? El amor que sintió por su Padre, que lo llevó a encarnarse.

Debemos aprender a amarnos unos a otros. Y, sinceramente, la única manera de hacerlo es si escuchamos sus palabras.

***“Amense los unos a los otros como yo les he amado.”***  
***(Jn 13,13)***

Siempre que amamos, debemos amar por amor a Jesús. Entonces nuestro amor será perfecto. Y nuestro amor nos hará humildes para hacer lo que es honorable para los demás. Acabo de llegar de un asilo de ancianos y celebré una misa de Pascua anticipada para ellos. Y, francamente, había tanta santidad presente que me estremecí. Estas personas eran tan honorables. Y a pesar de sus sufrimientos, no han perdido la fe.



Les hice muchas preguntas profundas sobre la Semana Santa. Y, sorprendentemente, sabían todas las respuestas. Las respondieron desde sus sillas de ruedas. Había un hombre deforme que parecía estar durmiendo todo el tiempo. Su sufrimiento, su cruz, era inmenso. Tenía llagas por todo el cuerpo. Me avergoncé de mis propias quejas absurdas sobre la vida. Cuando llegó el momento del Padrenuestro, empezó a hablar. Recitó el Padrenuestro de principio a fin. Lo había subestimado. Mi amor por Jesús me hizo humillarme y arrodillarme en el suelo junto a él. Desde el suelo, le di la Sagrada Comunión. Él sonrió. Yo lloré.

Comprendí brevemente a Jesucristo. Su amor al Padre lo llevó a humillarse, a rebajarse al nivel de la humanidad y a darnos su Cuerpo y su Sangre. Jesucristo debe ser amado especialmente. Solo él, por encima de todos los demás en el mundo, es nuestro buen y fiel amigo. Por él, que todos los hombres y mujeres sean especiales para ti. Ya sean tus amigos, discapacitados o enemigos, reza a Jesús por ellos. Ora para que todos conozcan a Jesús y lo amen. Entonces habrá paz en la tierra. Y como un verdadero santo, nunca anheles el amor especial ni la alabanza que solo le corresponde a Dios. Muchos músicos, actores y deportistas reciben demasiado amor y alabanza que solo Dios merece. Y nunca señalan a Jesucristo. Se convierten en ídolos. Dios no tiene igual.

Que Jesús esté en ti y en cada persona a quien Él favorece. Esta es nuestra oración. Esta es nuestra esperanza: que todos sean salvos por su preciosa sangre.

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. ... Let no soul fear to draw near to Me. ... It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.

**THE FIRST MILLENNIAL SAINT!**

Blessed Carlo Acutis, was born in London in 1991 to Italian parents and later moved to Milan, Italy. He died of leukemia in 2006 at the age of 15. He was known for his strong faith and his online efforts to spread the teachings of the Church.

He created an online exhibit about Eucharistic miracles. He was beatified, or declared "Blessed," by Pope Francis on October 10, 2020. A second miracle attributed to his intercession was recognized in May 2024, paving the way for his canonization during the Jubilee of Teenagers on April 27th.

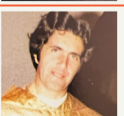
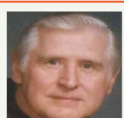
