



## FIRST BLESSING "URBI ET ORBI" OF HIS HOLINESS POPE LEO XIV.

Central Loggia of the Vatican Basilica  
Thursday, 8 May 2025.

Peace be with you all!

Dear brothers and sisters, these are the first words spoken by the risen Christ, the Good Shepherd who laid down his life for God's flock. I would like this greeting of peace to resound in your hearts, in your families, among all people, wherever they may be, in every nation and throughout the world. Peace be with you!

It is the peace of the risen Christ. A peace that is unarmed and disarming, humble and persevering. A peace that comes from God, the God who loves us all, unconditionally.

We can still hear the faint yet ever courageous voice of Pope Francis as he blessed Rome, the Pope who blessed Rome, who gave his blessing to the world, the whole world, on the morning of Easter. Allow me to extend that same blessing: God loves us, God loves you all, and evil will not prevail! All of us are in God's hands. So, let us move forward, without fear, together, hand in hand with God and with one another other! We are followers of Christ. Christ goes before us. The world needs his light. Humanity needs him as the bridge that can lead us to God and his love. Help us, one and all, to build bridges through dialogue and encounter, joining together as one people, always at peace. Thank you, Pope Francis!

## ENGLISH

During this Jubilee year, the Diocese of Saint Petersburg is challenging you. Parishioners, students, and all persons throughout our diocese are challenged to not only continue the work we are currently doing but to consider other charitable actions, or corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

Empowered by the message of our Pastoral Plan to Courageously Live the Gospel, the challenge is for our diocesan community, to together complete 1,000,000 works of mercy. The challenge began in January and ends on December 15, 2025, at 11:59 AM.

In the papal bull *Spes Non Confundit* ("Hope Does Not Disappoint"), Pope Francis wrote: "Works of mercy are also works of hope that give rise to immense gratitude. Care given to [those in particularly difficult situations, especially those affected by illnesses or disabilities that severely restrict their personal independence and freedom,] is a hymn to human dignity, a song of hope that calls for the choral participation of society as a whole."

The experience of mercy, whether we are the ones who give or those being helped, gives rise to joy. This is because mercy opens our hearts to the hope of new life. "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead" (1 Peter 1:3).

And so, in this Holy Year of Hope, we ask God not just for hope for ourselves but to help us be instruments of His hope for others. As part of the celebrations around the Jubilee Year, through the Works of Mercy, we will make His mercy manifest in our communities.

## ESPAÑOL

Durante este año jubilar, la Diócesis de San Petersburg los reta. Feligreses, estudiantes y todas las personas de nuestra diócesis están invitados no solo a continuar la labor que realizan actualmente, sino también a considerar otras acciones caritativas, u obras de misericordia corporales y espirituales.

Impulsados por el mensaje de nuestro Plan Pastoral para Vivir Valientemente el Evangelio, el reto es que nuestra comunidad diocesana complete, en conjunto, un millón de obras de misericordia. El reto comenzó en enero y finaliza el 15 de diciembre de 2025 a las 11:59 a. m.

En la bulsa *Spes Non Confundit* ("La esperanza no defrauda"), el papa Francisco escribió: "Las obras de misericordia son también obras de esperanza que suscitan una inmensa gratitud. La atención prestada [a quienes se encuentran en situaciones particularmente difíciles, especialmente a quienes padecen enfermedades o discapacidades que limitan gravemente su autonomía y libertad personal] es un himno a la dignidad humana, un canto de esperanza que llama a la participación coral de toda la sociedad".

La experiencia de la misericordia, ya seamos quienes damos o quienes recibimos la ayuda, genera alegría. Esto se debe a que la misericordia abre nuestros corazones a la esperanza de una nueva vida. "Bendito sea el Dios y Padre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, que según su gran misericordia nos ha hecho renacer a una esperanza viva, mediante la resurrección de Jesucristo de entre los muertos" (1 Pedro 1:3).

Así, en este Año Santo de la Esperanza, pedimos a Dios no solo esperanza para nosotros, sino que nos ayude a ser instrumentos de su esperanza para los demás. Como parte de las celebraciones del Año Jubilar, a través de las Obras de Misericordia, haremos que su misericordia se manifieste en nuestras comunidades.



The CMA is funding shared Catholic ministries and services in 3 groups: those that facilitate and offer others a chance to encounter our Lord and nurture the spiritual life of the people of our diocese; those that demonstrate an enthusiastic "YES!" in response to God's call to serve others; and those that support those who play such a vital role in forming missionary disciples throughout our diocese.

Administrative and business functions will not be funded through the *Catholic Ministry Appeal*. 100% of donations will go directly to ministry, programs, and outreach affecting people, communities, parishes, and schools. This includes pastoral outreach and service, formation, worship, discipleship and vocations. Additionally, donors are able to direct their donation to a specific ministry they may wish to support.



## PARTICIPATION **1**

Each parish is challenged to participate with at least 30% of registered families. The participation goal does not measure how much a family gives, but the amount of families that donate to the appeal from our community. In 2024, MHR closed the CMA with an 18% participation.

## GOAL **2**

Each parish's revenue is assessed and then given a personal goal. In 2024, MHR reached 86% of its goal. This year, we are challenged with a goal of \$95,616.00 and have contributed 21% of our goal already!
