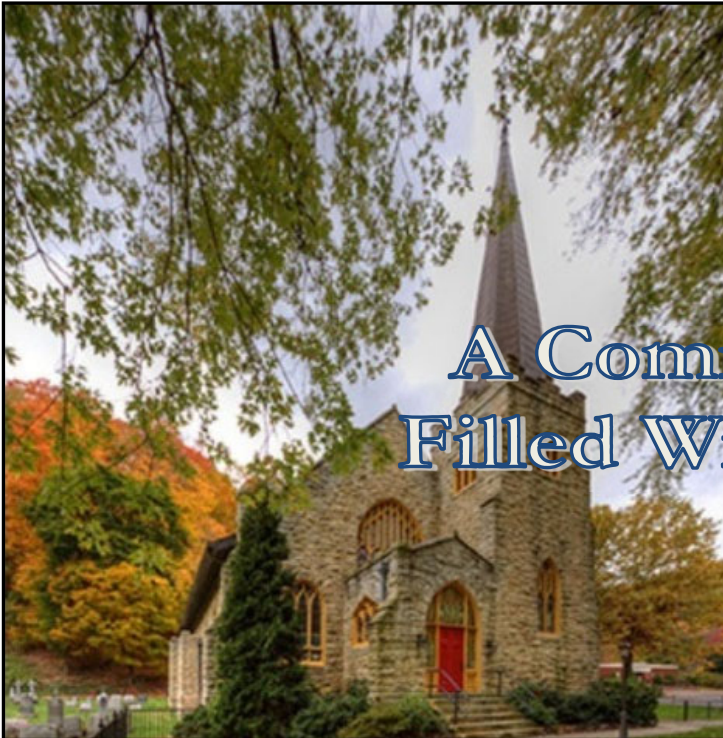




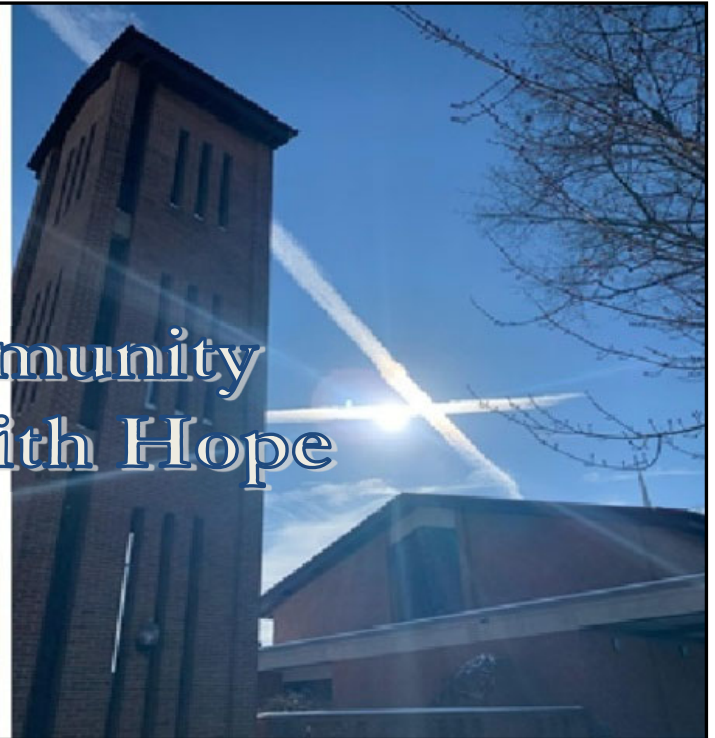

Fr. Brian “Behind the Mask”

The **Holy Eucharist** is God’s gift of Himself to sustain us, His Body of believers. We know we need His Presence to live. The limitations this year on the distribution and reception of this Gift have been a challenge for everyone. Thankfully we quickly made adaptations, many still in effect, in order to accommodate for safety, while maintaining reverence of the Sacrament.

Clergy and Extraordinary Ministers are instructed to wear masks during distribution and also to sanitize their hands whenever in direct contact with other persons. What I’ve found helpful also to reduce the risk of contact is if the one receiving Communion keeps his or her hands still and flattened when the Sacred host is placed on them.

We are happy to continue distributing Holy Communion outside. Like in places as St. Peter’s Square where outdoor liturgies are common, our ushers carry umbrellas with the Eucharist out of respect for Our Lord and to protect the Sacrament from above debris and the elements. This is why we use a canopy during our Eucharistic procession on Corpus Christi and why for outdoor Masses, the altar to is to be covered.



We are also glad that **Eucharistic Adoration** has resumed in our side chapel at St. James. To help us cover the hours needed, please sign-up in advance of the day. We are also blessed to have on loan a first-class relic of **Saint Peter Julian Eymard**, who had a great devotion to the Holy Eucharist. Through the prayers of

St. Eymard, we ask that the Lord send many more people to come and adore Him.

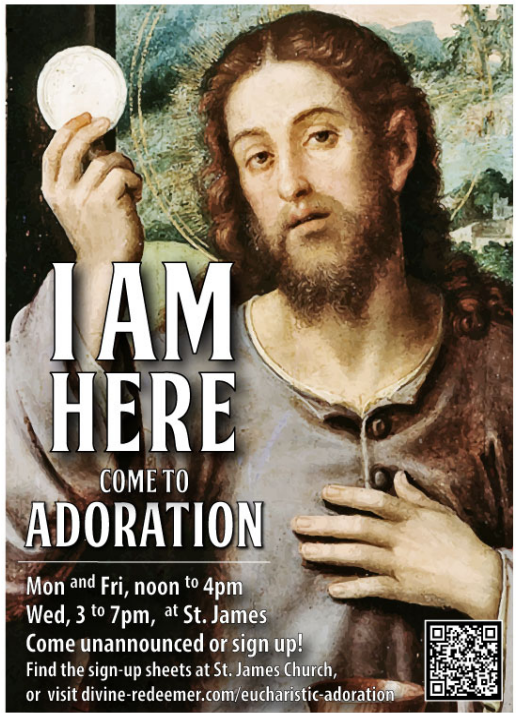
FINANCE COUNCIL UPDATES
