

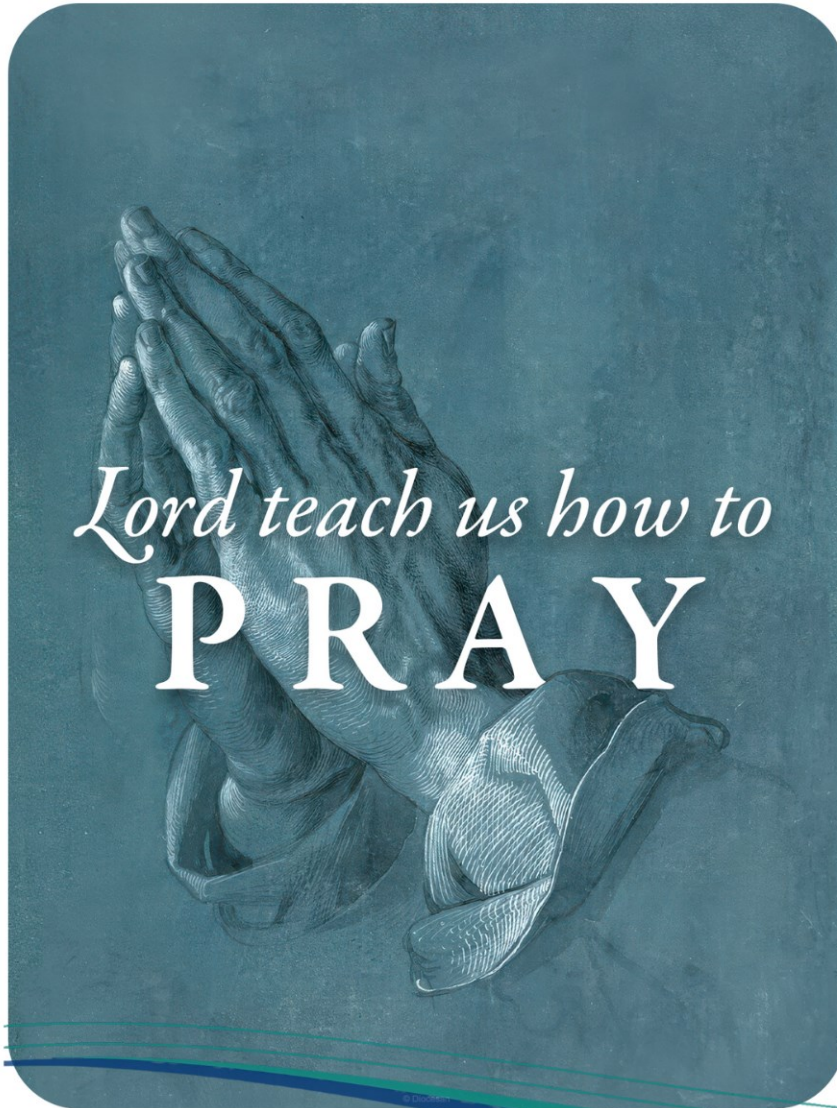

Homeless in Sewickley - Our first call to our answering machine on this particular day came in at 6:18am. A distraught young mother with an eight month old child was just kicked out of her boyfriend's house. She was able to find a place with a friend for a few hours, but needed shelter for the night.

The second call to our answering machine on that same day came in at 2:44pm asking for assistance. A single woman, who had been sleeping for the past five nights on church lawns in Sewickley and was seeking shelter. She was referred to us by the Sewickley YMCA.

We were able to make arrangements that day at a local motel and booked rooms for seven nights for both women. With the assistance of Respect Life, we were able to provide the mother with the young child diapers, wipes, baby formula, and other essentials. Arrangements were then made with a local community case worker to begin the process of securing more permanent housing.

Thanks to the donations of our parishioners, we have the resources to respond to these types of emergencies. Homelessness is not confined to only larger cities, it can be found in our own backyard. 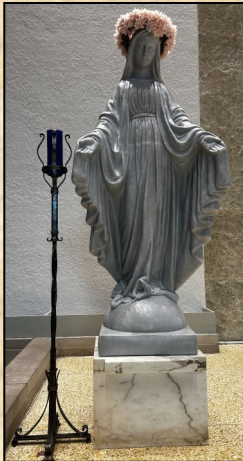

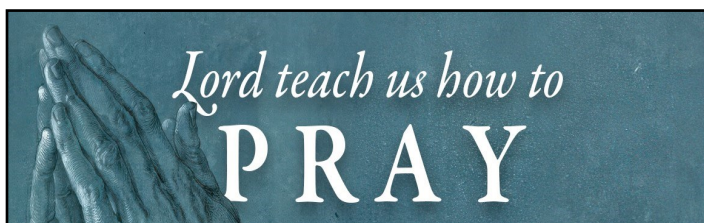
