



### ABOUT THE PASTORAL PLAN

The results of the Disciple Maker Index Survey provided important insights to our work on developing a new Pastoral Plan that will excite and engage Divine Redeemer Parishioners of all ages.

The Pastoral Council, has been putting together a roadmap to guide our parish's spiritual growth, strengthen our ministries, and create opportunities for deeper engagement in faith and service.

#### Our Findings: Mass Attendance, Prayer

Most parishioners attend Mass regularly, receive the Eucharist, believe in Scripture as the Word of God, and set aside time for daily prayer.

#### Our Opportunities: Enhancing Faith Practices

New and existing programs will enhance the faith growth of all parishioners and enhance our ability to evangelize. We will place greater emphasis on the Eucharist and faith building activities.

#### Our Priorities: Discipleship/Evangelization

Reach out to parishioners who do not regularly attend Mass, create evangelization opportunities from the Farmer's Market, expand bereavement program to include professional assistance.
