

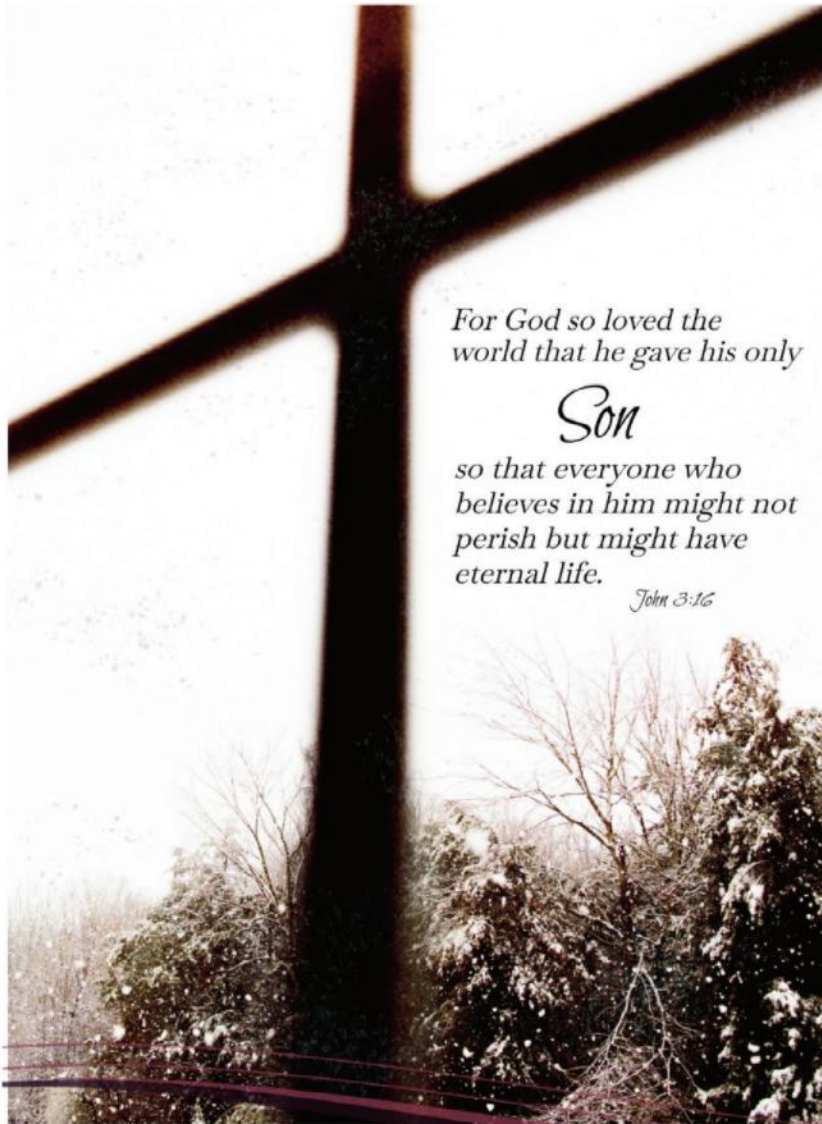

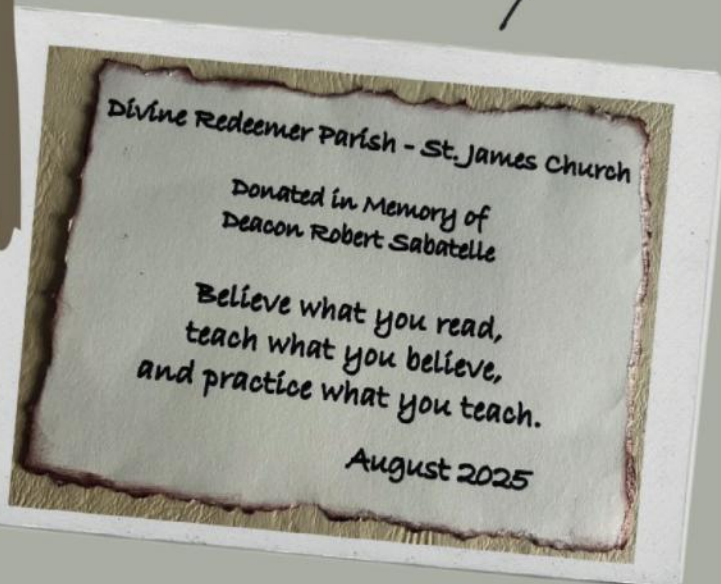

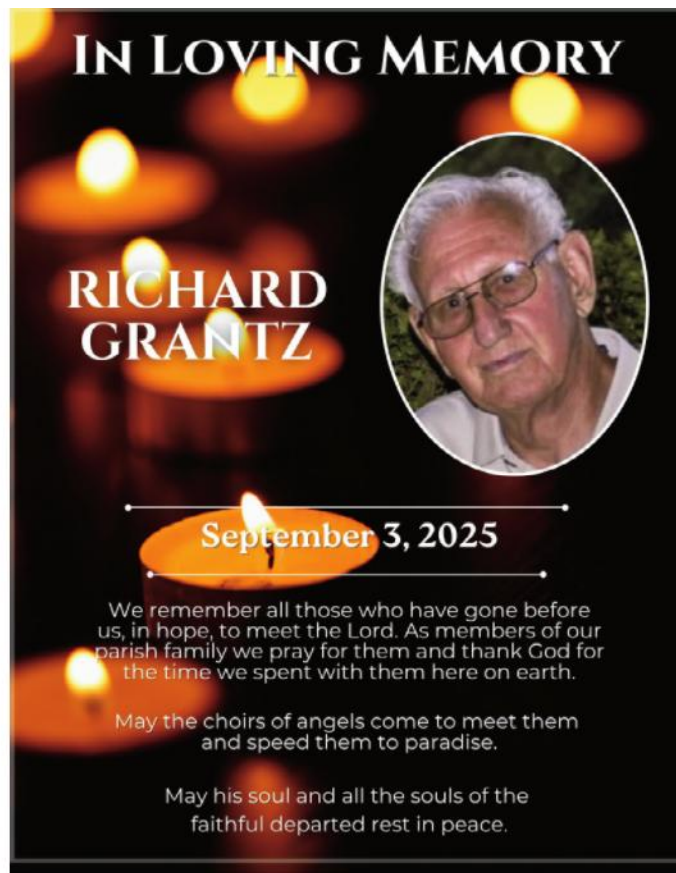

## CENTERING PRAYER

Contemplative Outreach of Pittsburgh is hosting an "Introduction to Forgiveness Prayer" Retreat. Presenting is Mary Dwyer of Erie, PA. For more information, please refer to <https://www.pghcenteringprayer.org/>.

The Pittsburgh Chapter of Contemplative Outreach (COP) is a Chapter of Contemplative Outreach, Ltd. and is comprised locally of 16 Centering Prayer Support Groups. Divine Redeemer of Sewickley has hosted St. James Centering Prayer Support Group; meeting for nearly 30 years. You will find more about this below.

Centering Prayer ~ Centering Prayer is a receptive method of silent prayer that prepares us to receive the gift of contemplative prayer, in which we experience God's presence within us, closer than breathing, closer than thinking, closer than consciousness itself. This method of prayer is both a relationship with God and a discipline to foster that relationship. Centering Prayer is not meant to replace other kinds of prayer. Rather, it adds depth of meaning to all prayer and facilitates the movement from more active kinds of prayer into a receptive prayer of resting in God. Centering Prayer emphasizes prayer as a personal relationship with God and as a movement beyond conversation with Christ to communion with Christ. Saint James Centering Prayer Group meets every Saturday for silent prayer, Lectio Divina, and spiritual study.

## JUST WHAT IS CHIMBOTE?



**Chimbote (pronounced “chim-bo-tay”)** is a city on the northwest coast of Peru (directly south of Pittsburgh) where a Catholic maternity hospital and medical clinic have been funded by Catholics of Pittsburgh for nearly 60 years. In 1965, Bishop John Wright sent several Pittsburgh priests to South America to locate a poor community that our Diocese could adopt as a sister church. The priests landed in the fishing town of Chimbote, Peru, and the mission began then and has flourished for nearly 60 years.

**In these six decades**, supported by Catholics of our Diocese, the maternity hospital has delivered 100,000+ babies. Moms, dads, and infants have been given excellent care. The medical clinic gives free treatment to thousands of needy residents each week. Also, a medical outreach program provides in-home visits and care for many poor families living in the barrios of Chimbote.

## Chimbote Perú Mission Dinner

Just what is our Diocesan mission in Chimbote, Peru? Chimbote is the Pacific coastal city in northwestern Peru where Catholic Christians of the Diocese of Pittsburgh have supported a maternity hospital and medical care clinic for the past 60 years! More than 100,000 children have been born in this Pittsburgh supported facility, and each week hundreds - even thousands - of needy and poor people receive medical attention and spiritual care.

Each October, a Pittsburgh fundraising dinner is held close to World Mission Sunday in an effort to continue the support given by our Catholic Diocese to the poor in Chimbote.

This year, the Peru Mission Dinner will be held on **Monday, October 13, 6:00pm**, at the Station Square Sheraton Hotel. Individuals, families, and groups are most welcome to attend in support of this truly worthwhile and beneficial charitable effort.

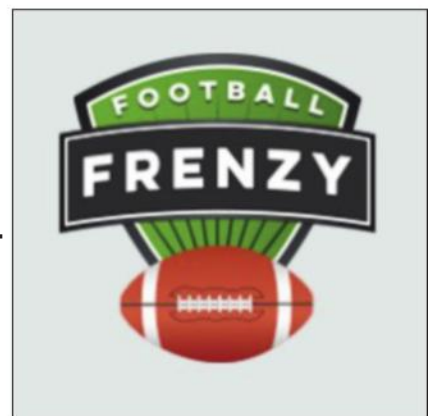
## KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS FOOTBALL FRENZY TICKETS

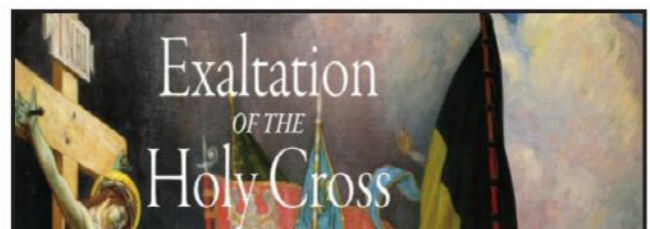

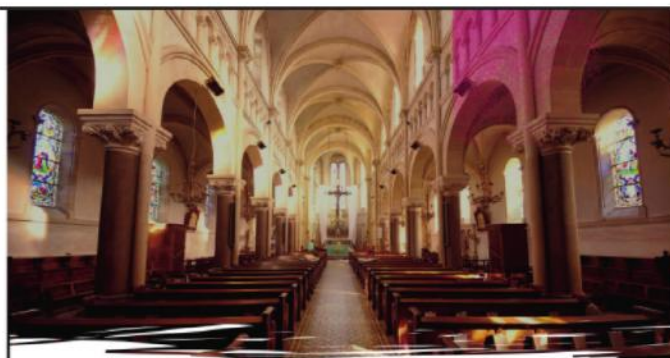
