THE WAY OF SAINT JAMES

Greetings everyone! I'm currently on pilgrimage with a group of parishioners who organized the trip on the Camino in northern Spain (September 16-26). You may remember that this spiritual excursion was first advertised at our Parish last year, with Fr. Rich Jones to be the chaplain. An unexpected knee surgery this summer caused Fr. Rich to cancel, as he took two months off his ministry at Mercy Hospital in order to rehabilitate. I was asked to go in his stead.

Many books and movies have been produced, highlighting this ancient pilgrimage to Santiago de Campostella, the town where the Apostle, Saint James, is traditionally known to be buried. El Camino, or "the Way," is actually a network of routes which converge at Santiago from other areas in Europe, principally through France, Portugal, and Malta. For centuries, travelers have made prayerful and penitential walks on foot or by donkey. Many moving accounts of healing, renewal, and transformation have been shared by those touched by the Holy Spirit along "the Way."

I am making this pilgrimage as my annual retreat, and taking each of you with me in my heart on this path to the altar of the Saint. I want to thank our clergy team, staff, and ministers for "holding down the fort." I was thinking, too, with gratitude that recently we've had more occasions for group trips as of late, including our daylong Jubilee pilgrimage to Ohio this summer, the pilgrim group which journeyed to Rome with Fr. Mele, as well as the annual March for Life in January!



Founder's Day Feast - On September 9, we honored the feast day of Blessed Frederick Ozama, founder of the Society of St. Vincent De-Paul, and a true witness of how the gospel comes alive when we serve the poor. Nearly two centuries after he first gathered with fellow univer-

sity students in Paris to form what will become our Society, his vision continues to shape and inspire our mission here in the Pittsburgh area and around the world.

Frederick was not a priest or religious, but a lay Catholic with a restless heart. At just 20 years old, Frederick and his companions resolved to put their faith into action by visiting the poor in their homes and offering what help they could. In these encounters, Frederick discovered something profound: that in serving the poor, we not only give but also we receive. He reminded us that Christ is present in the poor, and that when we draw close to them as our brothers and sisters, we draw closer to God.

Every day, members of our Divine Redeemer Conference, carry forward this spirit of humble service inspired by Blessed Frederick. We visit those in need in their homes and listen to their stories, pay overdue bills, bring food, pray with families and walk beside neighbors who feel forgotten.

This month, we thanks for Blessed Frederick's life and legacy. Our work is not just charity, but a vocation. It is the living out of Christ's call to love "the least of these." MARRIAGE


