Speaking of automotive things, you might not know that the Parish maintains its own group of vehicles, housed at Saint James and used regularly for ministry. First is a white, Ram

1500 4X4 truck (53,000 miles), great for everyday loading and hauling. Partnered with it is the white, Ford E350 van (39,000 miles), good not only for passengers, but with the seats out, very useful for extra-large loads, like our weekly fish fry supply runs in Lent. Finally, when Fr. Paul Esibu was a resident student in Sewickley and needing transportation to Duquesne, a generous benefactor donated to the Parish a black Lexus RX330 SUV (180,000 miles), which still works well, mostly for quick jaunts between our two churches.





From October 20th to 24th, sixty panels from the International Exhibition of the Eucharistic Miracles of the World will be on display at Divine Redeemer Parish. The exhibition was designed and created by Saint Carlo Acutis, a young man who used his gifts as a computer whiz to create a website cataloging every Eucharistic Miracle recorded in history. In 2006, he passed away at the age of 15 due to a rare type or leukemia. He was beatified only 14 years later in 2020 and canonized on September 7, 2025. By viewing this collection,

you can experience the history of these documented miracles, as well as learn about the faithful life of Saint Carlo and his journey to Sainthood.

MARRIAGE


